# CHIKMAGALUR

Chikmagalur known as the "Coffee Land of Karnataka" is a popular hill station in the Western Ghats, famous as the birthplace of coffee cultivation in India. Situated at an elevation with a pleasant climate, it features popular attractions like Mullayanagiri (highest peak in Karnataka), Bababudangiri, coffee plantation stays and scenic waterfalls.

## MULLAYANAGIRI (HIGHEST PEAK)

Mullayanagiri is the highest peak in Karnataka, India, standing at 1,930 meters (6,330 ft) in the Chandra Dhrona Hill Ranges of the Western Ghats, Chikkamagaluru. Known for its breathtaking panoramic views, temperate climate and lush greenery, it is a premier destination for trekkers and nature lovers, often called one of the best treks in Karnataka.

## BABA BUDANGIRI (DATTA PEETA)

Baba Budangiri (Datta Peeta) in Karnataka's Chikmagalur district is a revered mountain range in the Western Ghats known for the shared shrine of Sufi saint Baba Budan and Hindu deity Dattatreya. Rising over 1,800 meters, it is a key site for religious harmony, trekking and the birthplace of coffee cultivation in India.



## HEBBE FALLS

Hebbe Falls, located near Kemmangundi in Karnataka's Chikmagalur district is a stunning two stage waterfall cascading from 551 ft (168 meters) within a coffee estate. Known as Dodda Hebbe (big) and Chikka Hebbe (small), it is popular for its natural, herb enriched pool, accessible via a thrilling 8km forest jeep ride or trek, ideally visited from August to January.



## JHARI WATERFALLS (BUTTER MILK)

Jhari Waterfalls or Buttermilk Falls is a breathtaking two tier waterfall in Chikmagalur, Karnataka, nestled within dense coffee plantations and forests near Mullayanagiri. Known for its milky white appearance, this popular spot offers a natural pool at the base for visitors. Access is strictly via local Jeeps (~₹800/round trip) for the final 4-5 km.



## COFFEE MUSEUM

The Coffee Museum in Chikmagalur, Karnataka (often called the Coffee Yatra Museum) is a unique educational attraction run by the Coffee Board of India. It offers an in depth look at coffee history, cultivation, processing and brewing techniques in the "Coffee Land of India".



## HIREKOLALE LAKE

Hirekolale Lake is a serene man made reservoir located 9 km from Chikmagalur in Karnataka, surrounded by the scenic Western Ghats and Mullayanagiri hills. Known for its peaceful, scenic sunset views, it serves as a popular, free entry spot for tourists and photographers, typically accessible from 6 AM to 6 PM.





## KUDREMUKH NATIONAL PARK/PEAK

Kudremukh National Park, located in Karnataka's Chikmagalur district is a 600 km protected area in the Western Ghats known for its biodiversity, tropical wet evergreen forests and grasslands. The park's main feature is the "horse faced" (Kudremukha) peak, standing at 1,892–1,894 meters as Karnataka's second highest, offering a popular moderate level 4–5 hour trek through scenic landscapes.



## KEMMANGUNDI

Kemmangundi known as the 'Ooty of Karnataka' or Sri Krishnarajendra Hill Station is a scenic hill station in the Chikkamagaluru district nestled in the Baba Budan Giri Range. Located 1,434 meters above sea level, it offers a cool, pleasant climate, breathtaking mountain views, waterfalls and coffee plantations, making it a popular weekend getaway.



## MANIKYADHARA FALLS

Manikyadhara Falls known as the "Stream of Pearls," is a scenic 30 foot waterfall located in the Bababudangiri Hills of Chikmagalur, Karnataka. Surrounded by the Shola Forest, it is a popular, year round tourist spot and holy site for both Hindus and Muslims, often visited for its believed healing water properties.



## SRINGERI SHARADA PEETHA

The Sringeri Sharada Peetha, located in Karnataka on the banks of the Tunga River is the first of four cardinal Advaita Vedanta monastic institutions established by Adi Shankaracharya in the 8th century. Dedicated to Goddess Sharadamba (deity of knowledge), it is a renowned center for Vedic study and pilgrimage.
