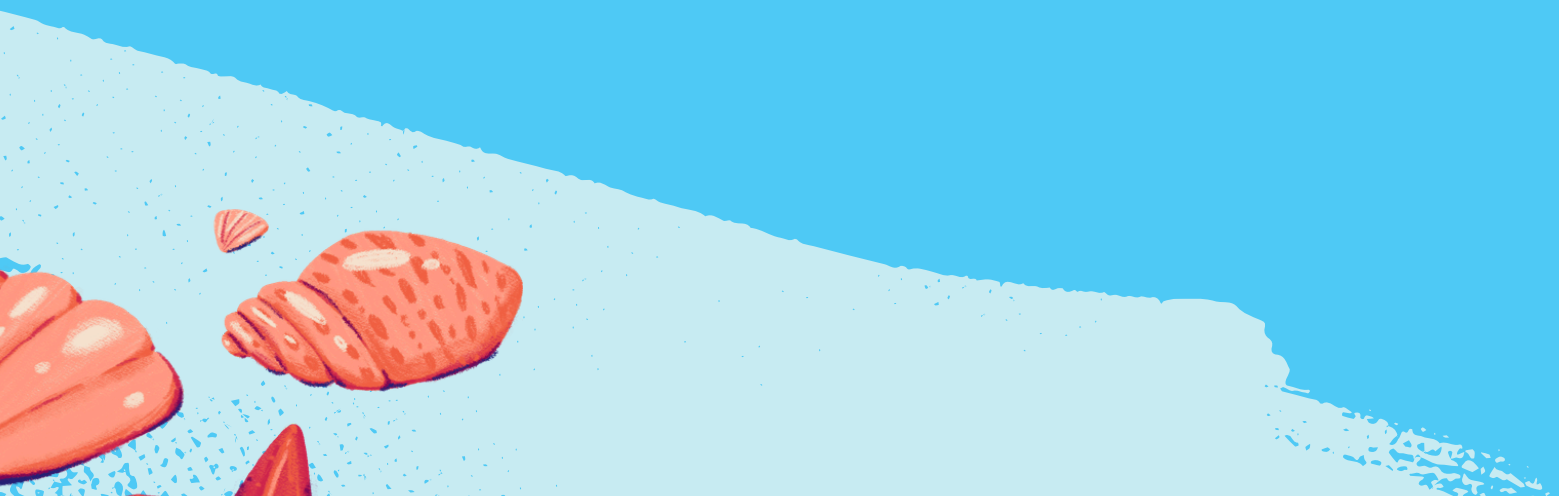

GOKARNA

Gokarna is a serene coastal town in Karnataka, India, famous for its ancient Hindu temples, particularly the Mahabaleshwar Temple which houses the Atmalinga. It offers a unique mix of spirituality and scenic beauty, featuring pristine beaches like Om Beach, Kudle Beach, and Half Moon Beach, making it a popular destination for both devotees and tourists.

OM BEACH

Om Beach located in Gokarna, Karnataka is a renowned coastal destination famous for its unique natural shape resembling the Hindu sacred symbol "Om". It features golden sands, rocky coves and is a popular spot for relaxing, water sports and enjoying stunning sunset views. The beach is accessible by road and offers a mix of tranquil, scenic beauty and adventure.



KUDLE BEACH

Kudle Beach located in Gokarna, Karnataka is a popular C shaped scenic beach renowned for its relaxed, bohemian vibe, stunning sunsets and tranquil atmosphere, making it a perfect spot for yoga, swimming and leisure. It offers a less commercialized alternative to Goa, featuring sandy shores, beach shacks and cafes serving diverse cuisines.



PARADISE BEACH

Paradise Beach in Pondicherry, located near the Chunnambar Boat House is a pristine secluded destination known for its golden sand and clear blue waters, accessible primarily by boat. Ideal for relaxation and water sports, this clean eco friendly beach offers activities like kayaking, jet skiing and boating between 9:00 AM and 5:00 PM





HALF MOON BEACH

Half Moon Beach in Gokarna, Karnataka is a secluded crescent shaped and tranquil escape known for its golden sands, clear waters and serene atmosphere. Primarily accessed by a scenic trekking trail from Om Beach or via motorboat. It offers a quieter alternative to mainstream beaches with basic, rustic shacks, ideal for relaxing, swimming, kayaking and camping.



GOKARNA BEACH

Gokarna Beach located in Karnataka's Uttara Kannada district is a popular coastal destination balancing sacred pilgrimage with tranquil, scenic shorelines. Situated near the Mahabaleshwar Temple. It offers a mix of spiritual significance, water sports and beachside cafes. It is known for its crescent shaped shores including Kudle and Om Beach.

MAHABALESHWAR TEMPLE



The Mahabaleshwar Temple in Gokarna is a 4th century Hindu pilgrimage site on the Arabian Sea coast widely revered as the "Dakshin Kashi" (Kashi of the South) due to its extreme sanctity. It is the home of the Atmalinga, a self manifested Shiva Linga that, according to legend was brought from Mount Kailash by Ravana and eventually rooted into the earth at this spot.



KOTI TIRTHA

Koti Tirtha is a sacred man made 6 acre holy water tank in Gokarna, Karnataka, known as a major center for ritual bathing and ancestral rites. Located walking distance from the Mahabaleshwar Temple. It is surrounded by temples and provides a tranquil spot for purification, often considered to possess the power of "ten million springs".



BHADRAKALI & GANAPATI TEMPLE

The Maha Ganapati and Bhadrakali temples in Gokarna are ancient revered shrines located near the main Mahabaleshwar Temple. The Maha Ganapati Temple houses a 5 ft Ramayana era idol traditionally visited first to seek blessings before visiting the Atmalinga. The Bhadrakali Temple is a tranquil spot dedicated to a protective goddess.

MIRJAN FORT

Mirjan Fort is a 16th century 11.8 acre historical, moss covered fort located near Gokarna on the banks of the Aghanashini River in Karnataka. Built of laterite stone, it was constructed by Queen Chennabhairadevi (known as the "Pepper Queen") and features high walls, eight bastions and a scenic tranquil environment.



YANA CAVES

Yana Caves located about 48 km from Gokarna in Karnataka's Western Ghats are famous for two massive unique black limestone rock formations Bhairaveshwara (390 ft) and Mohini (300 ft) shikhara. Accessible via a short scenic forest trek these caves are a popular day trip offering a blend of nature and mythology best visited between October and March.



MURUDESHWAR

Murudeshwar, located about 80 km from Gokarna is a renowned temple town famous for the world's second tallest Shiva statue (123 feet) overlooking the Arabian Sea. Situated on Kanduka Hill, it features a 20 story Raja Gopura, offering panoramic views via a lift. It is a top spiritual and photography spot often paired with Gokarna trips.



HONNAVAR

Honnavar located just 50 km from Gokarna is a serene coastal town and hidden gem in North Karnataka. Nestled between the Arabian Sea and Western Ghats, it features the unique Sharavathi backwaters, extensive mangrove forests and the pristine Kasarkod Eco Beach. It is an ideal, less crowded alternative or addition to a Gokarna trip.

JOG FALLS

Jog Falls located about 130 km (3 to 4 hour drive) from Gokarna in Karnataka's Shimoga district is India's second highest plunge waterfall, dropping 830 feet (253 meters) in four distinct cascades (Raja, Rani, Roarer, Rocket). Best visited during the monsoon (August–December), it offers spectacular views of the Sharavathi River.
