KASOL

Kasol located in Himachal Pradesh's Parvati Valley is a scenic popular mountain village known as the "Mini Israel of India" for its vibrant Israeli culture and laid-back bohemian atmosphere. Nestled along the Parvati River, this high-altitude hamlet acts as a prime base for adventure treks like Kheerganga and Chalal making it popular for backpacking, cafes and scenic nature walks.

MANIKARAN SAHIB



Manikaran Sahib is a prominent pilgrimage site for both Sikhs and Hindus located in the Parvati Valley of Himachal Pradesh, India, near Kasol nestled at 1,760m elevation on the banks of the Parvati River. Known for its naturally hot sulfur springs the Gurudwara Sahib is famously associated with Guru Nanak Dev Ji's visit and features hot springs used for cooking the langar (community kitchen).

KHEER GANGA PEAK & TREK



Kheerganga is a popular beginner-friendly trek (approx. 9-12 km) in Himachal Pradesh's Parvati Valley, ending at a scenic spot 3,000–3,500m high. Famed for its natural hot springs (hot water springs) set against snow-capped peaks. It offers a 2-day experience featuring waterfalls, pine forests and a spiritual serene atmosphere.



CHALAL VILLAGE

Chalal is a serene pedestrian-only village in Himachal Pradesh's Parvati Valley, located a short 30–45 minute walk from Kasol. Known for its quiet bohemian vibe, traditional pine-wood houses, and stunning views of the Parvati River. It is a popular spot for backpackers, Israeli tourists and nature lovers seeking a peaceful retreat.



TOSH VILLAGE

Tosh is a scenic bohemian village in Himachal Pradesh's Parvati Valley perched at 2,400 meters. Known as a "hippie paradise," it offers panoramic Himalayan views, apple orchards, and traditional wooden homes making it popular for backpackers, trekkers and travelers seeking a quiet rustic retreat.

NATURE PARK KASOL

Nature Park Kasol is a serene riverfront park located in the Parvati Valley of Himachal Pradesh, India. Offering a tranquil escape among pine forests and the banks of the Parvati River. Open daily from 8:30 AM to 6:30 PM it features walking trails, scenic picnic spots and a small children's play area. Making it ideal for relaxation and photography.



GRAHAM VILLAGE

Graham Village is a serene remote hamlet in Himachal Pradesh's Parvati Valley (approx. 2,300m altitude), popular for a 4–5 hour (8-10 km) scenic hike from Kasol. Known for its traditional wooden houses, mountain views and lack of cellular connectivity. It offers a peaceful rustic escape. The trek is ideal for beginners.



PULGA AND KALGA VILLAGE

Pulga and Kalga are serene scenic and non-commercialized villages in Himachal Pradesh's Parvati Valley, Popular for backpacking, apple orchards, traditional wooden homes and pine forests. Located near Barshaini .They are accessible via a short hike and offer a peaceful escape near Kasol and the Kheerganga trekking route.



MALANA VILLAGE

Malana is a secluded, ancient village in Himachal Pradesh's Parvati Valley renowned as one of the world's oldest democracies with its own distinct parliamentary system. Famed for high-quality "Malana Cream" hashish. The village is culturally isolated with residents believing they are descendants of Alexander the Great's army.

PARVATI RIVER

The Parvati River in Kasol is a stunning crystal-clear river originating from the Man Talai Glacier flowing through the heart of Himachal Pradesh's Parvati Valley. It is known for its swift turquoise-white waters surrounding pine forests, and dramatic mountain views serving as a primary attraction for nature lovers, campers and backpackers.
