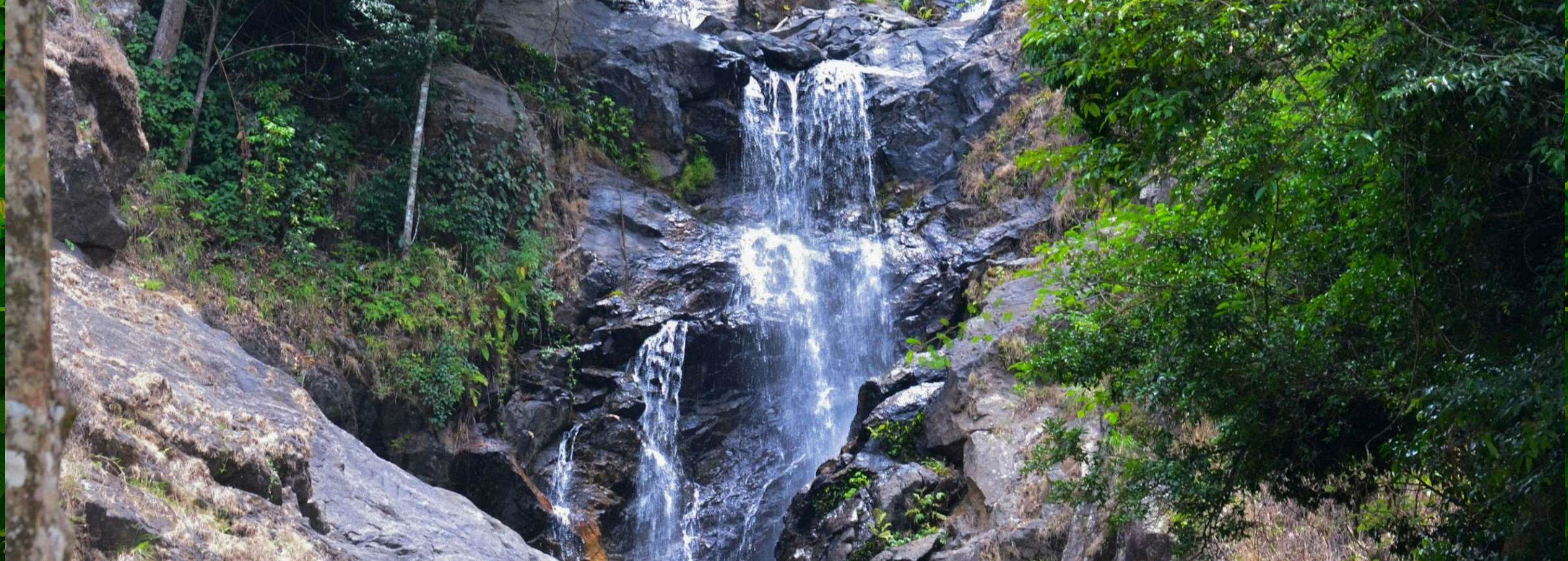
ABBEY FALLS

Abbey Falls, located 6-8 km from Madikeri in Karnataka's Kodagu district, is a stunning 70-foot waterfall cascading within private coffee and spice plantations. Known for its roar, it features a hanging bridge viewing point, making it a popular, easily accessible tourist spot best visited during the monsoon, though it's open year-round.



MALLALI FALLS

Mallalli Falls is a stunning 200 foot, two tiered waterfall located in the Western Ghats (Kodagu/Coorg district, Karnataka) at the foothills of Pushpagiri Range. Formed by the Kumaradhara River, it is best visited between July and December (monsoon/post monsoon) for maximum flow. It is a popular nature spot accessible via stairs and is roughly 26km from Somwarpet.



IRUPPU FALLS

Iruppu Falls, also known as Lakshmana Tirtha Falls is a stunning 170 foot, multi tiered waterfall cascading down the Brahmagiri Range in Coorg, Karnataka, surrounded by lush Western Ghats forests. Located near the Rameshwara Temple, it is a popular nature and pilgrimage spot offering a moderate, scenic 1 km jungle trek to the falls.



DUBARE ELEPHANT CAMP

Dubare Elephant Camp, located on the banks of the Kaveri River in Karnataka's Kodagu district is a premier eco-tourism center focused on elephant interaction, training and conservation. Run by Jungle Lodges and Resorts, it offers visitors opportunities to feed, watch and learn about elephants from expert mahouts and naturalists.

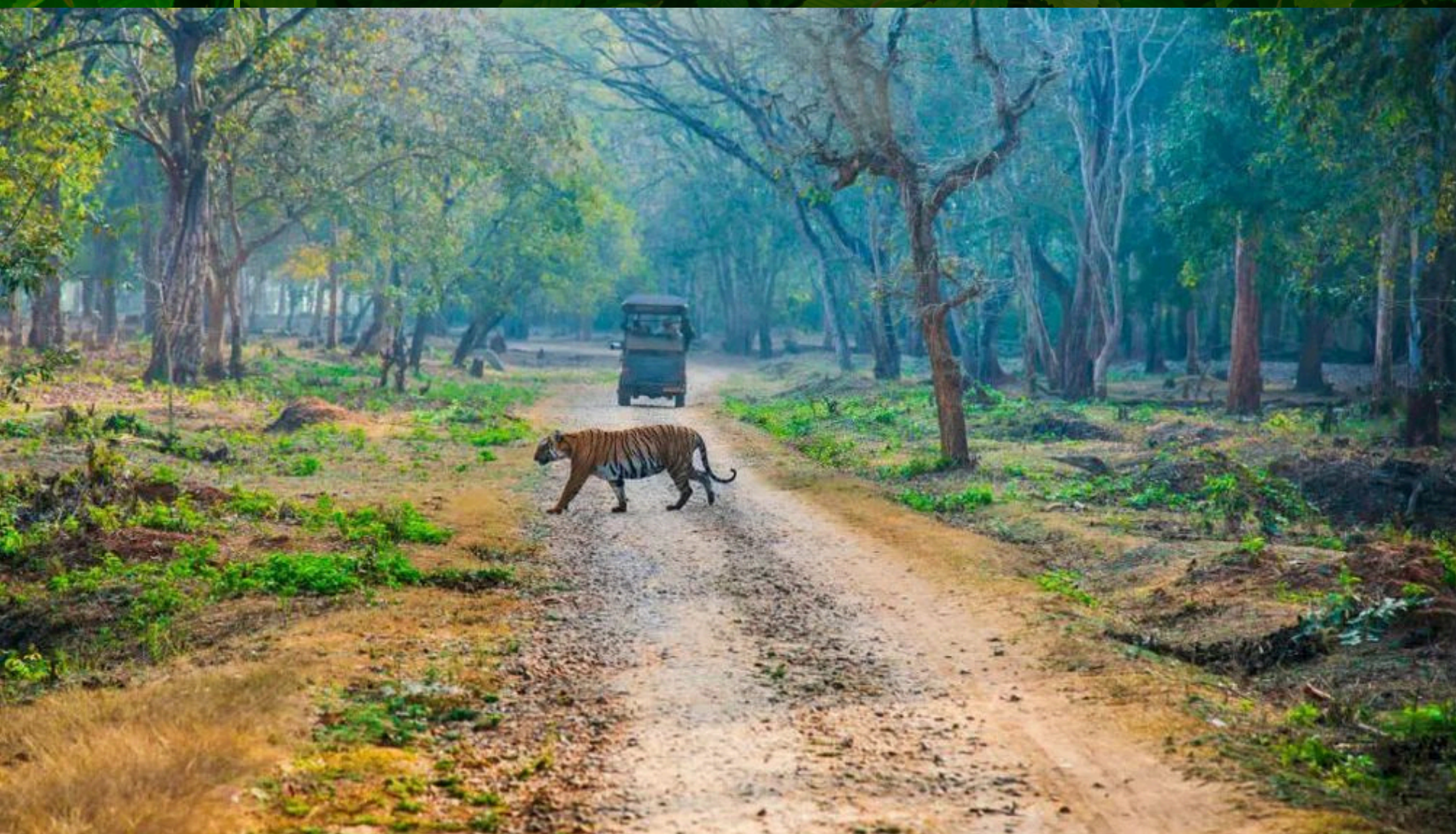


NISARGADHAMA

Kaveri Nisargadhama is a 64 acre eco friendly river island park located near Kushalnagar in Coorg, Karnataka, surrounded by the Kaveri River. Accessible via a hanging bridge, it features lush bamboo groves, teak trees, sandalwood trees, and attractions like a bird park, elephant rides and boating.

NAGARHOLE NATIONAL PARK

Dubare Elephant Camp, located on the banks of the Kaveri River in Karnataka's Kodagu district is a premier eco-tourism center focused on elephant interaction, training and conservation. Run by Jungle Lodges and Resorts, it offers visitors opportunities to feed, watch and learn about elephants from expert mahouts and naturalists.



MANDALPATTI

Mandalpatti is a breathtaking 1,600 meter high viewpoint in Coorg, Karnataka known as "Mugilu peth" (Market of Clouds) for its panoramic mist covered views of the Western Ghats. Located 18 km from Madikeri near Abbey Falls, it offers stunning sunrises and requires a 4x4 jeep ride through coffee estates and forest terrain.

TADIANDAMOL

Tadiandamol at 1,748 meters is the highest peak in Coorg and the third highest in Karnataka, offering a popular, moderate 14–16 km round trip trek. Located in the Brahmagiri Wildlife Sanctuary, it is renowned for lush shola forests, rocky trails, grasslands and rewarding panoramic views of the Western Ghats.





NAMDROLING MONASTERY (GOLDEN TEMPLE)

The Namdroling Monastery or Golden Temple in Bylakuppe, Karnataka is the world's largest Nyingma lineage teaching center, established in 1963 by Penor Rinpoche. It is a stunning Tibetan Buddhist center famed for 40–60 foot gold plated Buddha statues, vibrant murals and a peaceful atmosphere hosting over 5,000 monks and nuns.



OMKARESHWARA TEMPLE

Built in 1820 by King Lingarajendra II, the Omkareshwara Temple in Madikeri (Coorg) is a unique historic shrine dedicated to Lord Shiva. It is renowned for its distinctive architectural blend of Gothic and Islamic styles, featuring a central dome and four corner minarets. The temple also features a peaceful water tank and is located about 1 km from the town center.
