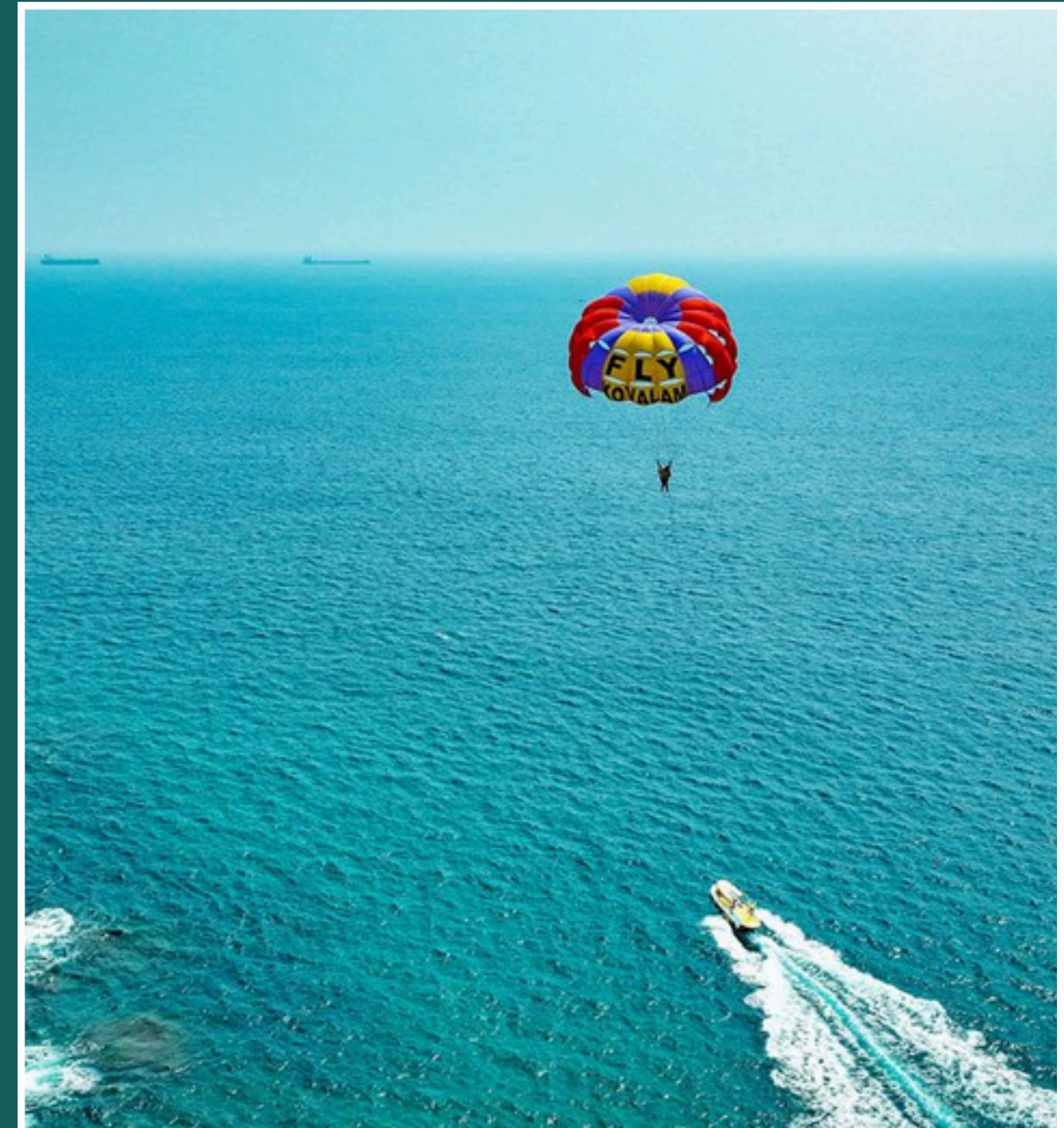

KOVALAM

Kovalam is a world renowned coastal town in Kerala, India, famous for its three adjacent crescent shaped beaches Lighthouse, Hawa and Samudra separated by rocky headlands. Located near Thiruvananthapuram, it is a major tourist destination known for shallow waters, Ayurvedic massages, water sports and vibrant nightlife, catering to both domestic and international visitors.

LIGHTHOUSE BEACH

Lighthouse Beach, located in Kovalam, Kerala is a popular southern destination known for its iconic 30-meter red and white lighthouse. It features white sand, panoramic Arabian Sea views and numerous cafes. Popular for swimming, surfing and climbing the lighthouse, it is best visited from October to March.





HAWA BEACH (EVE'S BEACH)

Hawa Beach also known as Eve's Beach is a scenic, crescent shaped and less crowded beach in Kovalam, Kerala, often noted for its dramatic, strong waves and beautiful sunset views. Separated from Lighthouse Beach by the Edakkalu foreland, it is a favored spot for swimming, sunbathing and viewing palm groves, providing a peaceful alternative to the main tourist area.



SAMUDRA BEACH

Samudra Beach located in the northernmost part of Kovalam, Kerala is a serene, less crowded alternative to the main Lighthouse Beach, ideal for relaxation and sunset viewing. Known for its pristine shores, rocky outcrops and traditional fishing, this quiet beach offers a romantic escape with scenic views of the Arabian Sea.

VIZHINJAM MARINE AQUARIUM (SAGARIKA)

The Vizhinjam Marine Aquarium (Sagarika), located near Kovalam Beach is a budget friendly, educational attraction showcasing a variety of seawater fish, coral and notably large sea turtles. Managed by the Government of Kerala, it features interactive exhibits and specialized research on pearl production, making it ideal for families visiting for short, 30–45 minute tours.

VIZHINJAM ROCK CUT CAVE TEMPLE

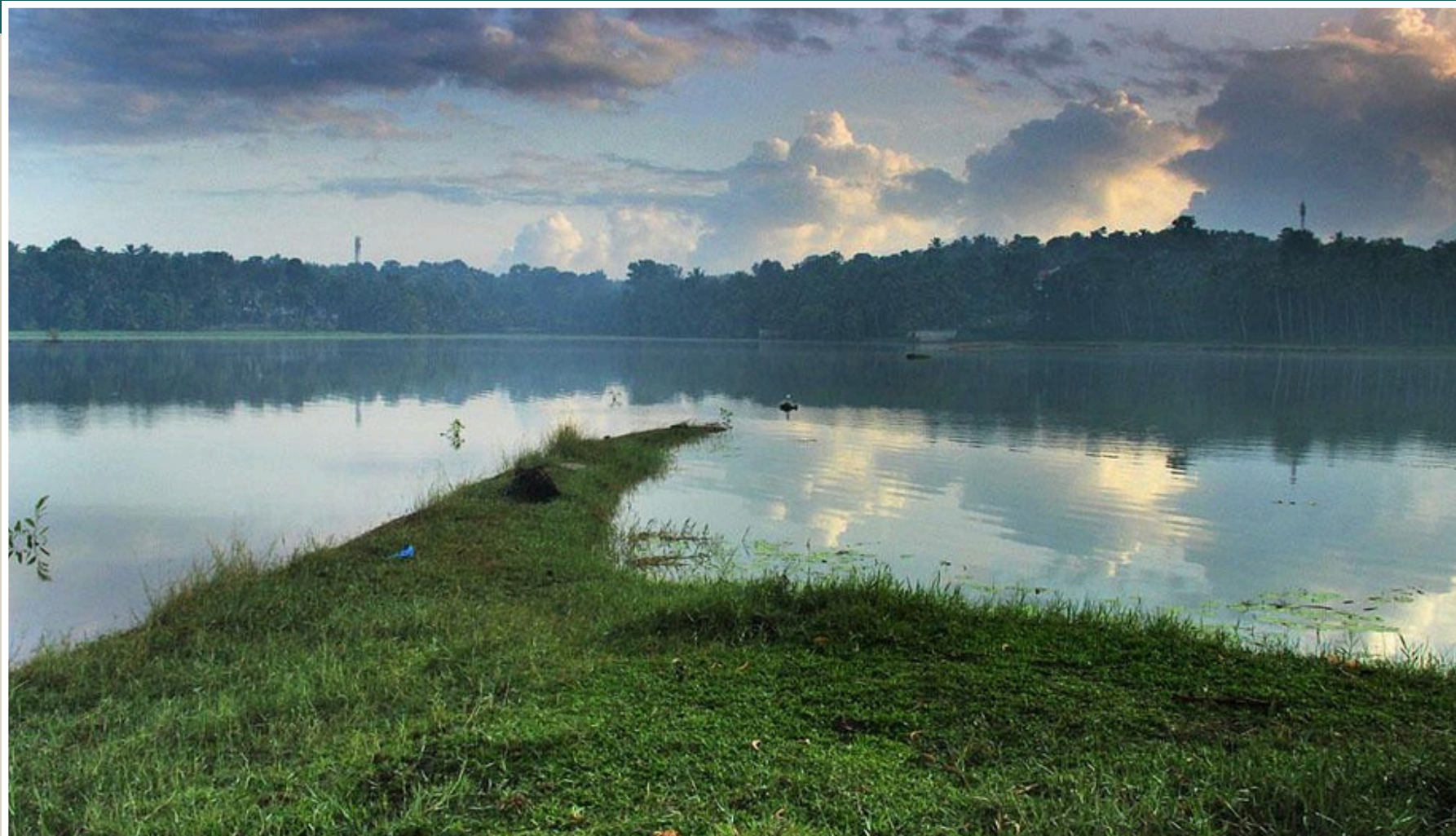
The Vizhinjam Rock Cut Cave Temple located just 2–3 km from Kovalam Beach in Kerala is a remarkable 8th-century heritage site. Carved from a single massive granite boulder, it is one of the smallest and oldest rock-cut shrines in South India.





VELLAYANI LAKE

Vellayani Lake (Vellayani Kayal) is the largest freshwater lake in Thiruvananthapuram district, located about 7 km from Kovalam, renowned for its tranquil atmosphere, scenic lotus blooms and picturesque sunset views. It is an ideal spot for nature lovers, photography enthusiasts and eco tourism, featuring a road that cuts through the water.



HALCYON CASTLE

Halcyon Castle, also known as Kovalam Palace is a historic 1932 summer retreat built in traditional Kerala colonial style by Sri Rama Varma Valiya Koil Thampuran for Maharani Sethu Lakshmi Bayi. Located in Kovalam, it was converted into a luxury hotel/heritage site, offering panoramic sea views, lush gardens and scenic tranquil surroundings.

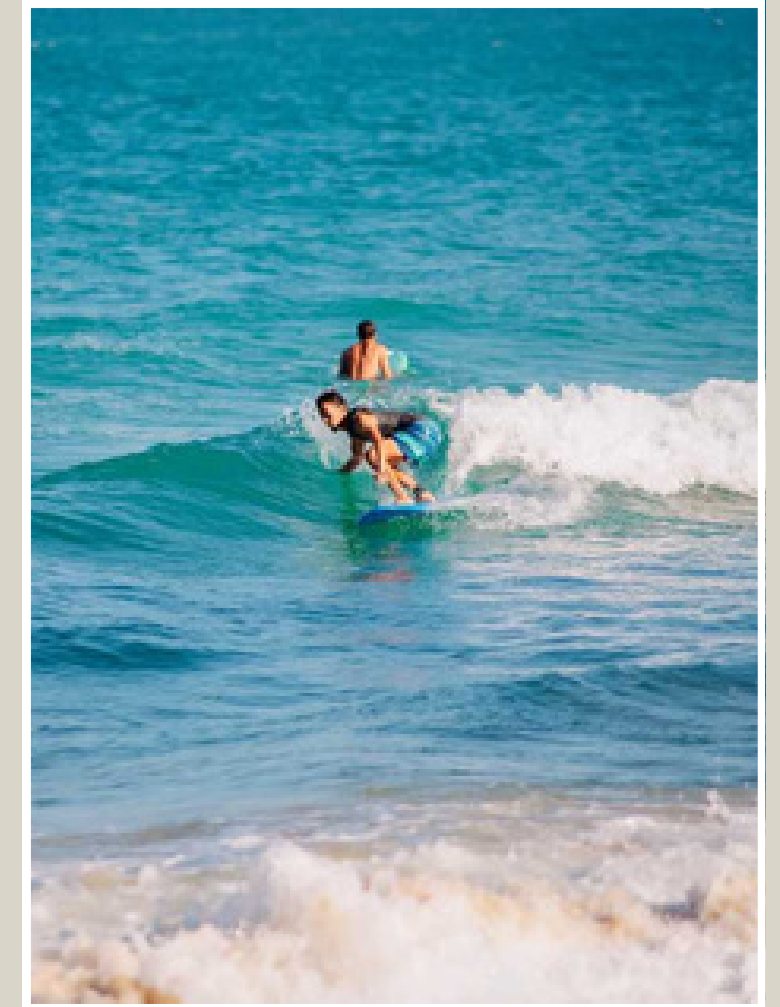




AZHIMALA SHIV TEMPLE

The Aazhimala Shiva Temple, located near Kovalam in Kerala is a stunning coastal shrine famous for its massive 58 foot tall concrete statue of Lord Shiva in the Gangadhara form. Perched on a cliff overlooking the Arabian Sea, it is a major spiritual and artistic landmark known for its serene atmosphere and unique dramatic ocean views.

POOVAR ISLAND



Poovar Island, located near Kovalam in Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala is a serene coastal destination famous for its unique estuary where the Neyyar River, backwaters and Arabian Sea meet. Accessible only by boat, it offers uncrowded golden sand beaches, lush mangroves, floating cottages and peaceful sunset cruises.
