PAHALGAM

Pahalgam the "Valley of Shepherds" in Jammu & Kashmir, is a premier hill station situated at 2,130m along the Lidder River in Anantnag district. Known for its scenic beauty, it serves as the base for the annual Amarnath Yatra and is famous for hiking, trout fishing and trekking. Key attractions include Betaab Valley, Aru Valley, and Baisaran (Mini-Switzerland), with best visits from April to June for green landscapes or January to March for snow.

BETAAB VALLEY



Betaab Valley, located 15 km from Pahalgam in Jammu & Kashmir's Anantnag district, is a breathtaking destination known for its lush meadows, pine forests and the sparkling Lidder River. Named after the 1983 Bollywood movie Betaab, it is a top attraction offering stunning views of snow capped mountains and a peaceful atmosphere.





ARU VALLEY

Aru Valley is a scenic, tranquil village and popular tourist destination nestled in the Himalayas near Pahalgam, Jammu and Kashmir, known for its lush green meadows, pine forests and breathtaking snow capped peaks. Located at an altitude of 2,400 meters, it serves as a base camp for trekking, including the Kolahoi Glacier and Tarsar Marsar Lake and features the scenic Lidder River.



BAISARAN VALLEY

Baisaran Valley, located 5 km from Pahalgam in Jammu and Kashmir, is a lush pine fringed meadow nicknamed "Mini Switzerland" for its scenic beauty. Known for its panoramic views of the Lidder Valley and snowcapped peaks, this hilltop destination is popular for horse riding, trekking and camping, acting as a base for Tulian Lake.





CHANDANWARI

Chandanwari, located 16 km from Pahalgam in Kashmir at 2,895 meters, is a scenic snow covered valley best known as the starting point for the annual Amarnath Yatra pilgrimage. Open year round, it offers popular activities like snow sledging on its bridge, pony rides and views of the Lidder River, with heavy snow from November to May.

TULIAN LAKE

Tulian Lake is a pristine high altitude alpine lake situated at approximately 12,087 ft (3,684 m) in the Pir Panjal Range near Pahalgam, Jammu & Kashmir. Known for its brilliant blue waters, icebergs and figure eight shape, it is a moderate to challenging trek offering panoramic views of the Himalayan peaks.



SHESHNAG LAKE

Sheshnag Lake is a stunning, high altitude oligotrophic lake located near Pahalgam in Jammu and Kashmir, India, situated at an elevation of roughly 3,590–3,658 meters (11,778–12,001 feet). Renowned for its crystal clear blue green waters, it is a key site on the Amarnath Yatra pilgrimage, surrounded by lush meadows and snow capped peaks and is considered the sacred abode of the serpent king, Sheshnag.



LIDDER RIVER

The Lidder River is a scenic 73-kilometer long crystal-blue river flowing through the Pahalgam valley in Jammu and Kashmir, India. Originating from the Kolahoi Glacier, it is a key tributary of the Jhelum River, renowned for trout fishing, white water rafting and its vital role in agricultural irrigation.



OVERA ARU WILDLIFE SANCTUARY

Overa Aru Wildlife Sanctuary, located near Pahalgam in Jammu and Kashmir is a ~500 sq km protected area known for its rich alpine biodiversity including the endangered Hangul (Kashmir stag) and Musk deer. Established in 1981, it features dense coniferous forests, lakes and high altitude grasslands, making it popular for wildlife photography, birdwatching and hiking.
