SAKLESHPUR

Sakleshpur is a scenic hill station in Karnataka's Western Ghats (Hassan district) renowned as the "Switzerland of Karnataka" for its cool climate, lush coffee/spice plantations and immense biodiversity. Located on NH 48 between Bengaluru and Mangalore, it is a popular destination for trekking, nature lovers and plantation stays featuring attractions like Manjarabad Fort, Jenukal Gudda and Bisle Viewpoint.

MANJARABAD FORT

Manjarabad Fort in Sakleshpur is a unique 18th century, star-shaped fort built in 1792 by Tipu Sultan designed to defend against the British and control regional trade routes. Situated at 987.8 meters above sea level, it features 8 points large granite walls and a deep moat. It is open daily from 8 AM to 5 PM with no entry fee.



BISLE GHAT VIEWPOINT

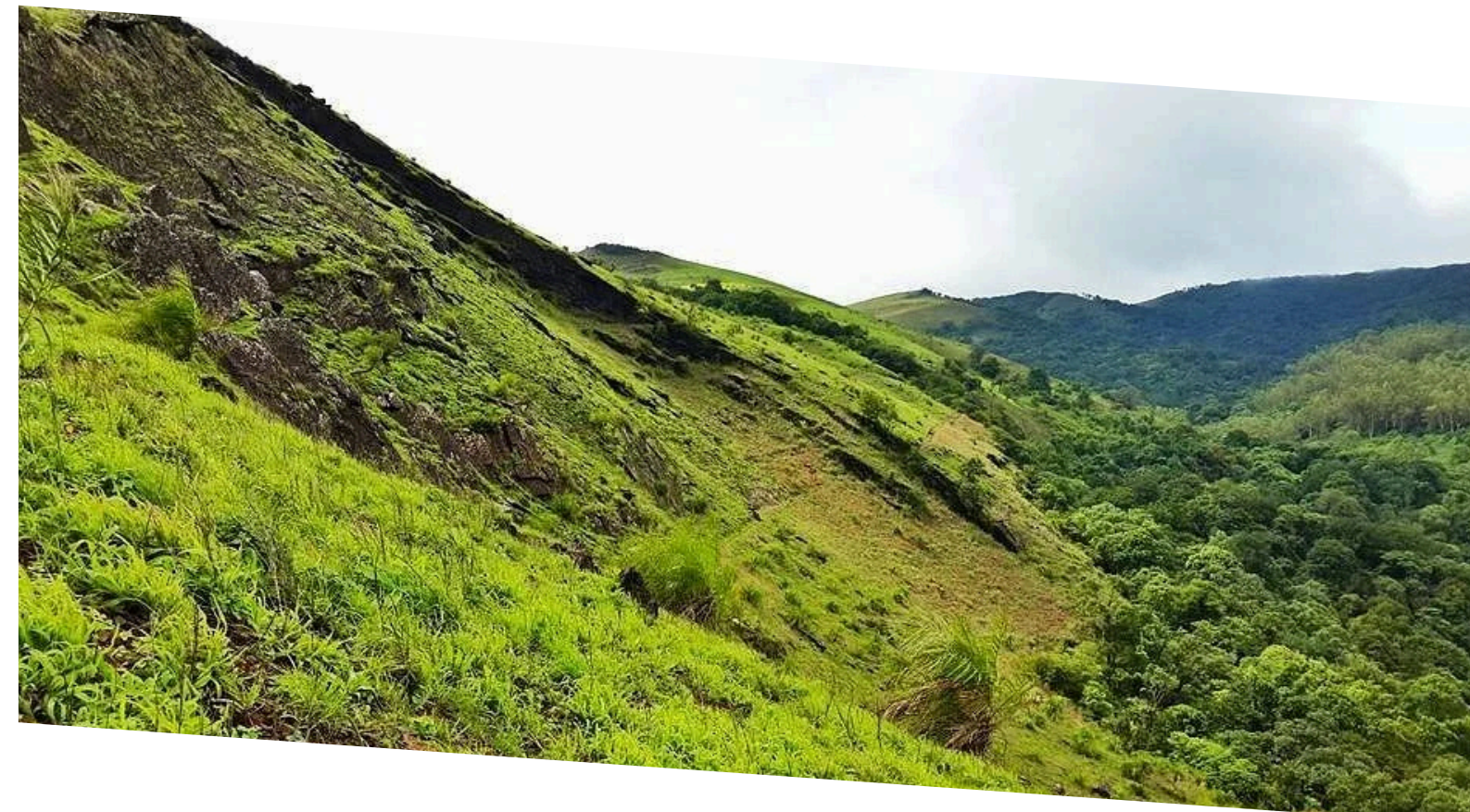
Bisle Ghat Viewpoint is one of the most stunning panoramic vantage points in the Western Ghats, located near Sakleshpur in the Hassan district of Karnataka. It is famously perched at an altitude of approximately 3,800 feet above sea level, offering a "360 degree" view of three major mountain ranges: Kumara Parvatha, Pushpagiri and Dodda Betta.

JENUKAL GUDDA

Jenukal Gudda (or Jenukallu Peak) is the second highest peak in Karnataka, standing 4,500 feet above sea level near Sakleshpur. Known for its panoramic views of the Western Ghats and trekking trails, it offers stunning views of surrounding coffee plantations and on clear days, the Arabian Sea. It is best visited between October and March.

AGNI GUDDA HILL

Agni Gudda Hill ("Fiery Mountain") in Agani village, near Sakleshpur, is a popular, moderate trekking and camping destination known for panoramic views of surrounding green rice terraces and coffee plantations. Located 25 km from Sakleshpur, the 3 km trek takes about 1 hour and is ideal for sunset viewing, camping and picnics.





HEMAVATHI RESERVOIR

The Hemavathi Reservoir (Gorur Dam), located near Sakleshpur in Hassan district is a 58.5 meter high earthen dam built in 1979 across the Hemavathy River. It serves as a vital irrigation and drinking water source with a 2,810 sq km catchment area. Popular for its scenic beauty, the dam features 6 radial gates and nearby attractions like the submerged Shettihalli Church.

MURKANNU GUDDA & HADLU WATERFALL

Murkannu Gudda and Hadlu Waterfalls in Sakleshpur offer a thrilling, combined trekking experience through lush Western Ghats forests and coffee plantations. Located about 23km from Sakleshpur, the trek features scenic hill views at Murkannu Gudda (3,900 ft) and a multi stage, icy waterfall at Hadlu.





MAGAJAHALLI ABBI FALLS

Magajahalli Abbi Falls (also known as Hanbal Falls or Abbi Gundi Falls) is a scenic tiered waterfall located approximately 20 km from Sakleshpur town in Karnataka. Nestled at the foothills of the Pushpagiri Mountain range, it drops from a height of about 20 feet, creating a refreshing natural pool at its base. It is a popular spot for families and nature lovers due to its easy accessibility. It is just a short 100 meter walk from the main road.



OMBATTU GUDDA

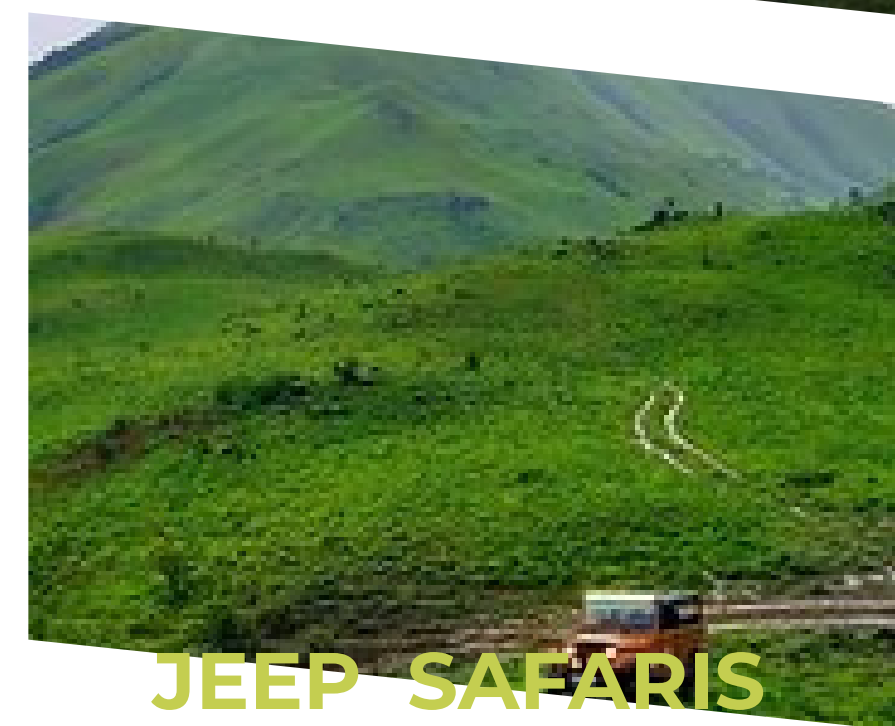
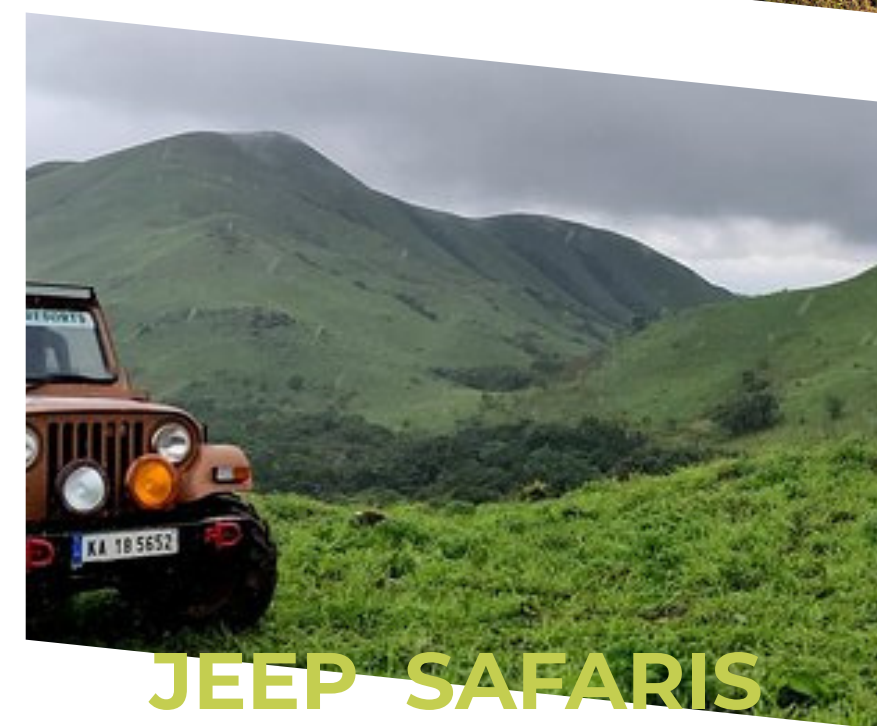
Ombattu Gudda (Nine Hills) in Sakleshpur is a challenging 6-hour trek (971m altitude) located within the dense, pristine Kabbinala Reserved Forest, often accessed via Gundya checkpost. Renowned for its steep terrain, streams, bamboo thickets and rich wildlife. This trek offers a rewarding panoramic view of the Western Ghats.



BETTADA BYRAVESHWARA TEMPLE

Bettada Byraveshwara Temple is an ancient 600 year old hilltop shrine dedicated to Lord Shiva, located approximately 35 km from Sakleshpur near Mekanagadde. Perched atop the Pandavara Gudda hill, it offers a breathtaking 360 degree panoramic view of the Western Ghats and is a popular destination for both spiritual seekers and trekking enthusiasts.
