Udupi is a renowned coastal city in Karnataka, India, celebrated as a major spiritual, educational and culinary hub. Famous for the 13th century Sri Krishna Matha, pristine beaches like Malpe and St. Mary's Islands and the birthplace of authentic South Indian Udupi vegetarian cuisine. It is a key pilgrimage and tourism destination.

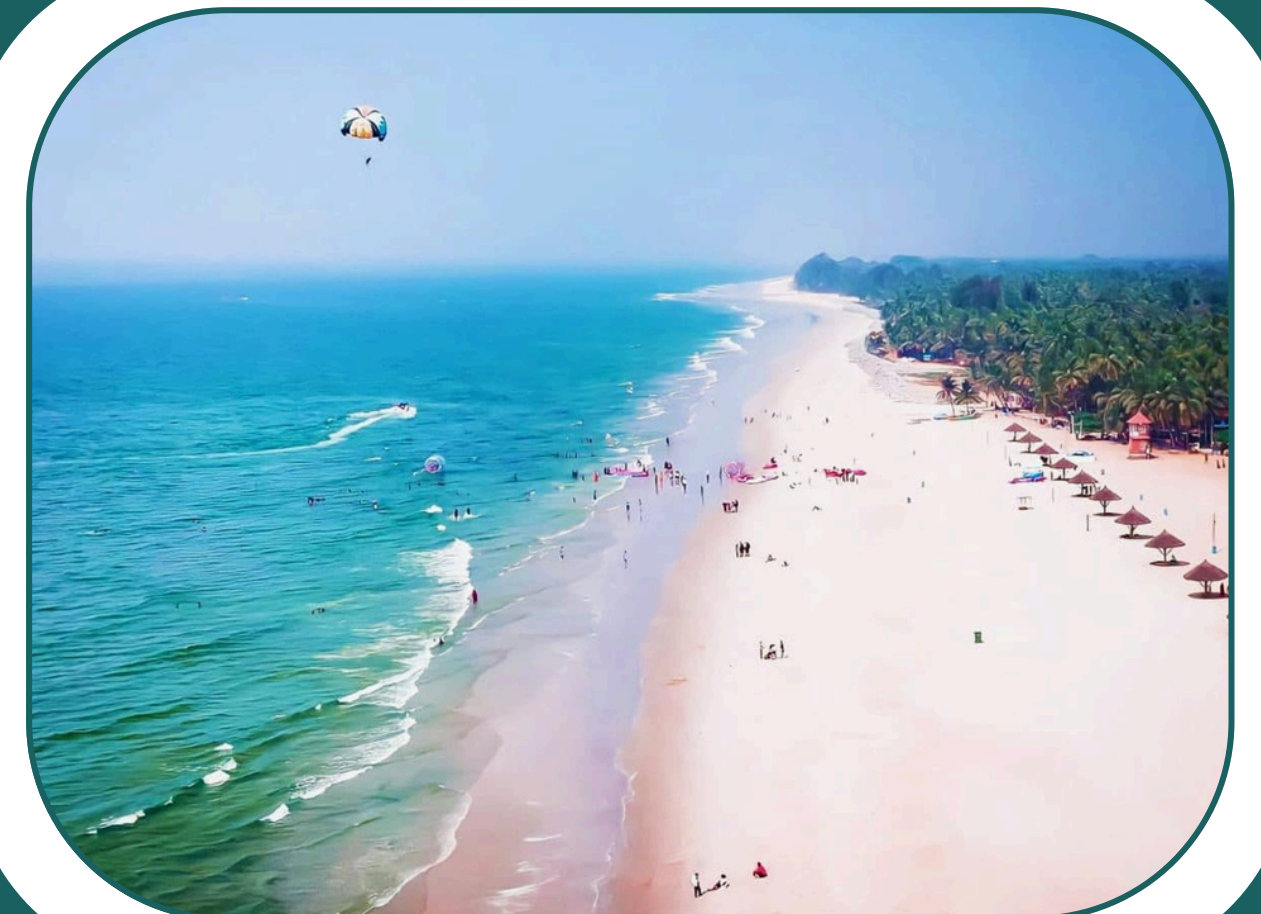
SRI KRISHNA MATHA / TEMPLE

The Udupi Sri Krishna Matha is a famous 13th century Hindu temple in Karnataka dedicated to Lord Krishna, established by Saint Madhvacharya. Famous for its unique worship through a 9 holed window (Kanakana Kindi) and a west facing Balakrishna idol. The temple operates under the rotational management (Paryaya festival) of eight monasteries.



MALPE BEACH

Malpe Beach located 6 km from Udupi, Karnataka is a popular scenic destination known for its golden sand, clean shores and vibrant water sports. As a key natural fishing harbor and tourist spot, it offers ferry rides to St. Mary's Island, a scenic sea walk and operates 24 hours without entry fees.





ST. MARY'S ISLAND

St. Mary's Islands or Coconut Island are a set of four small picturesque islands in the Arabian Sea off the coast of Malpe in Udupi, Karnataka. Renowned for unique hexagonal columnar rhyolitic lava rock formations formed 88–90 million years ago, this Geological Survey of India protected site offers white sandy beaches and turquoise waters.



KAPU (KAUP) BEACH & LIGHTHOUSE

Kapu (also known as Kaup) Beach is a serene and picturesque destination in the Udupi district, famous for its historic 27-meter lighthouse. Built in 1901 by the British. The lighthouse stands atop a massive boulder and remains operational guiding ships through the Arabian Sea.

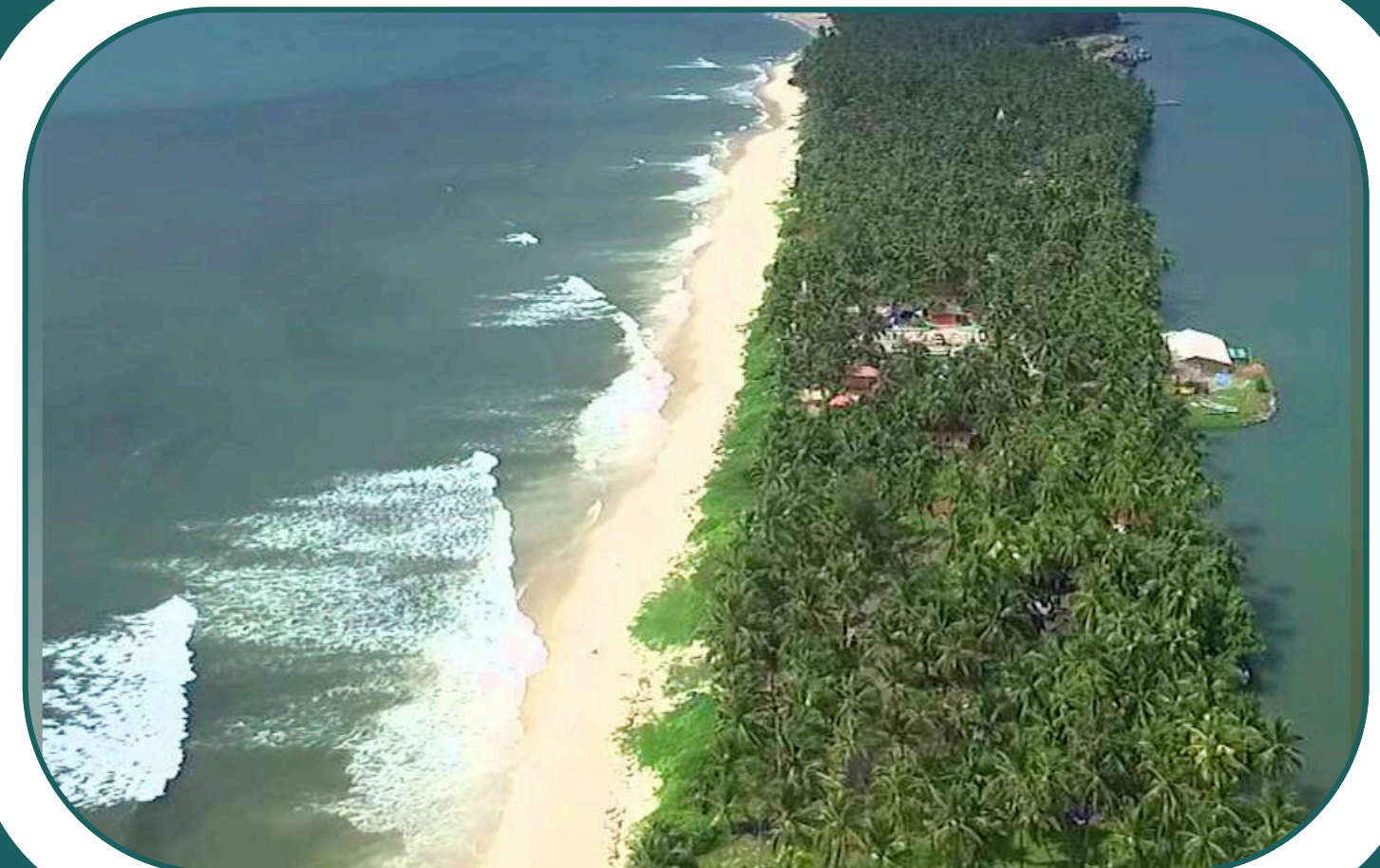


MATTU BEACH

Mattu Beach located near Katpadi in Udupi is a serene relatively secluded coastal stretch known for its long, golden sands, lush coconut groves and stunning sunsets. Offering a quiet alternative to busier beaches. It features a unique narrow landscape bordered by the Arabian Sea on one side and the scenic backwaters of the Pangala River on the other.

DELTA POINT / BENGRE BEACH

Delta Point also known as Bengre Beach or Kodi Bengre Beach is a scenic estuary near Udupi where the Suvarna River meets the Arabian Sea. It is located approximately 9–14 km from Udupi town and is celebrated for its peaceful, offbeat atmosphere compared to more commercial beaches like Malpe.



KARKALA

Karkala located in Karnataka's Udupi district is a historically significant town known as a major Jain pilgrimage center, featuring the famous 42 foot monolithic Gomateshwara statue. Situated near the Western Ghats. It boasts numerous basadis (temples) including the Chaturmukha Basadi and serves as a quiet, scenic and culturally vibrant hub.



MARAVANTHE BEACH

Maravanthe Beach in Udupi, Karnataka is a unique scenic destination where the Arabian Sea and the Souparnika River run parallel, separated only by NH66. Known as "Virgin Beach". This spot offers stunning, serene views, golden sands and is a popular stop for photography, swimming and water sports, often praised as one of India's most beautiful road drives.



KUDLU THEERTHA FALLS

Kudlu Theertha Falls, located near Hebri in the Western Ghats (approx. 42-47 km from Udupi) is a 300 foot breathtaking waterfall on the River Sita. Known as a "hidden" gem, it features a scenic 30-40 minute jungle trek to a pool surrounded by lush greenery. It is open daily (approx. 9 AM–5 PM) with an entry fee.
