VAGAMON

Vagamon is a serene scenic hill station on the Idukki-Kottayam border in Kerala, India, situated 1,100 meters above sea level. Known as the "Scotland of Asia," it offers a cool climate, lush green tea plantations, pine forests and meadows. Popular activities include paragliding, trekking and visiting sites like the Glass Bridge and Kurisumala Ashram.

VAGAMON MEADOWS (KOTTATHUPARA)

Vagamon Meadows (often associated with nearby Kottathupara or locally as Mottakkunnu) are sprawling lush green rolling hills in Idukki, Kerala, famed for their misty atmosphere and scenic beauty. Located near the Vagamon-Elappara route, these meadows are ideal for walking, photography, picnics and activities like paragliding.



PINE FOREST/PINE VALLEY

Vagamon Pine Forest/Pine Valley in Kerala is a popular scenic 6 acre tourist spot featuring dense, towering, British era man made pine trees. Located on the Vagamon-Elappara road, it is a key destination for photography, nature walks and relaxing in a cool atmosphere.

THANGALPARA



Thangalpara, located near Vagamon in Kerala's Idukki district is a stunning 2,500 meter high rocky hill, renowned as a popular Muslim pilgrimage site and scenic tourist destination. It features a massive, legendary spherical boulder the tomb of Sufi saint Husrath Sheikh Fariduddin Baba offering breathtaking panoramic views, trekking opportunities and a serene atmosphere.

VAGAMON GLASS BRIDGE (ADVENTURE PARK)

The Vagamon Glass Bridge, located in Kerala's Idukki district is India's longest cantilever glass bridge (40 meters) situated 3,600 feet above sea level within a DTPC adventure park. Opened in September 2023, this attraction offers panoramic views of the Vagamon hills, with reinforced German glass holding up to 15 people.



KURISUMALA ASHRAM



Kurisumala Ashram in Vagamon, founded in 1958 by Acharya Francis Mahieu and Fr. Bede Griffiths is a renowned Christian monastery blending Indian monastic traditions with Trappist spirituality. Situated at 4,000 feet, it is a serene, sustainable hub known for its dairy farm and a 14-cross trekking trail up the holy hill.

MURUGAN HILL



Murugan Mala (Murugan Hill), located near Vagamon in Kerala's Idukki district is a popular serene pilgrimage spot famous for its rock cut temple dedicated to Lord Murugan. Situated on the eastern side of Kurisumala Hill, this attraction offers panoramic views of the surrounding hills and valleys, making it ideal for trekking, nature walks and photography.



MARMALA WATERFALLS

Marmala Waterfalls is a scenic 60 meter (200-foot) waterfall nestled in a private rubber estate near Teekoy in Kerala's Kottayam district, often called the "hidden jewel" of the Western Ghats. It forms a 12 meter deep pool on the Meenachal River, requiring a roughly 2km trek through rocky, slippery terrain. The falls are best visited between October and March for safe, clear views.

VAGAMON LAKE

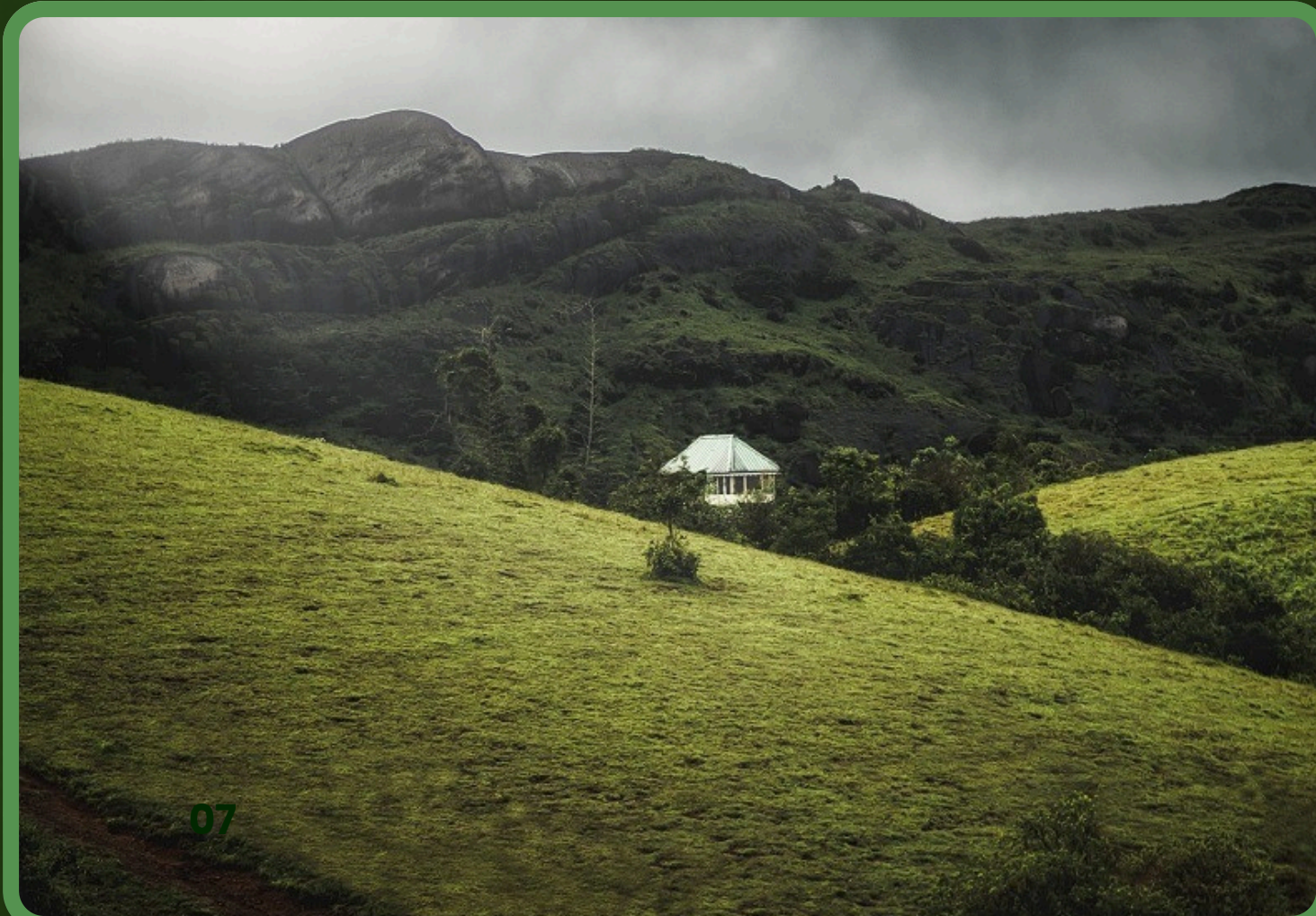
Vagamon Lake is a serene, small natural lake located in the Idukki district of Kerala, surrounded by green tea plantations and rolling hills. Popular for boating and leisure, it is a key attraction in the hill station, offering activities like pedalo boating, rowing and walking trails along the banks.





KARIKADU VIEWPOINT

Karikadu View Point is a prominent roadside vantage point located on the Vagamon Erattupetta Road, roughly 4.5 km from the Vagamon bus stand. Often described as the "gateway" to the hill station, it offers panoramic vistas of the Western Ghats, characterized by deep valleys, sky high mountains and winding rock cut roads.



ULURUPUNI TOP STATION

Uluppuni Top Station is a serene lesser known viewpoint located approximately 10–15 km from Vagamon on the Idukki–Kottayam border. Known as "Kerala's mini Munnar," it is celebrated for its vast, rolling meadows and thrilling off-road trails that lead to panoramic vistas of the Western Ghats and the Kulamavu Dam reservoir.

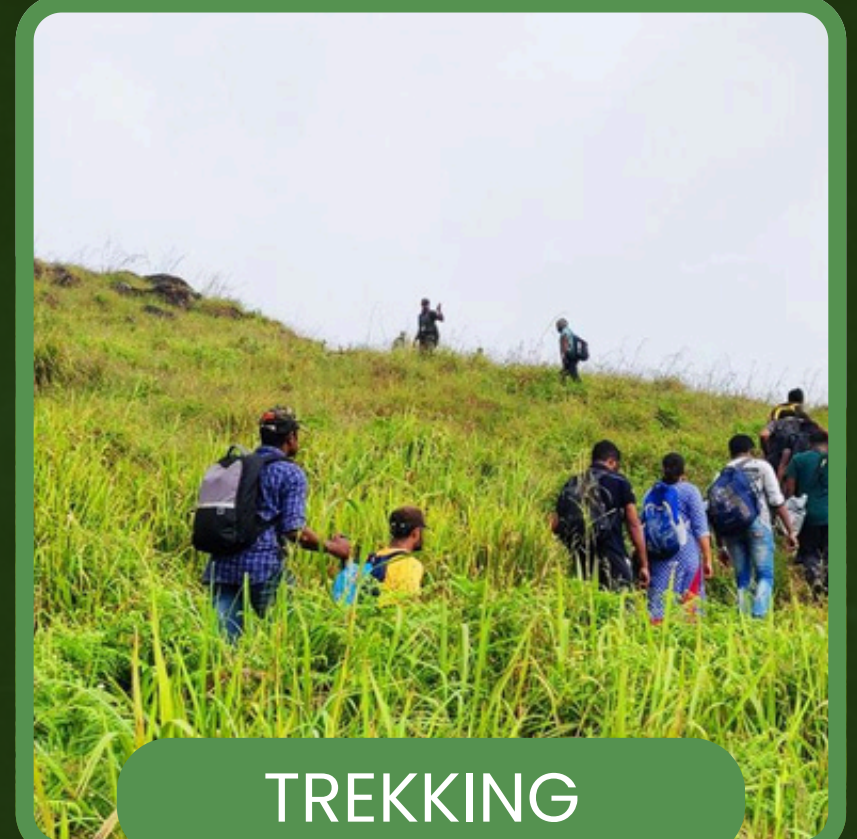
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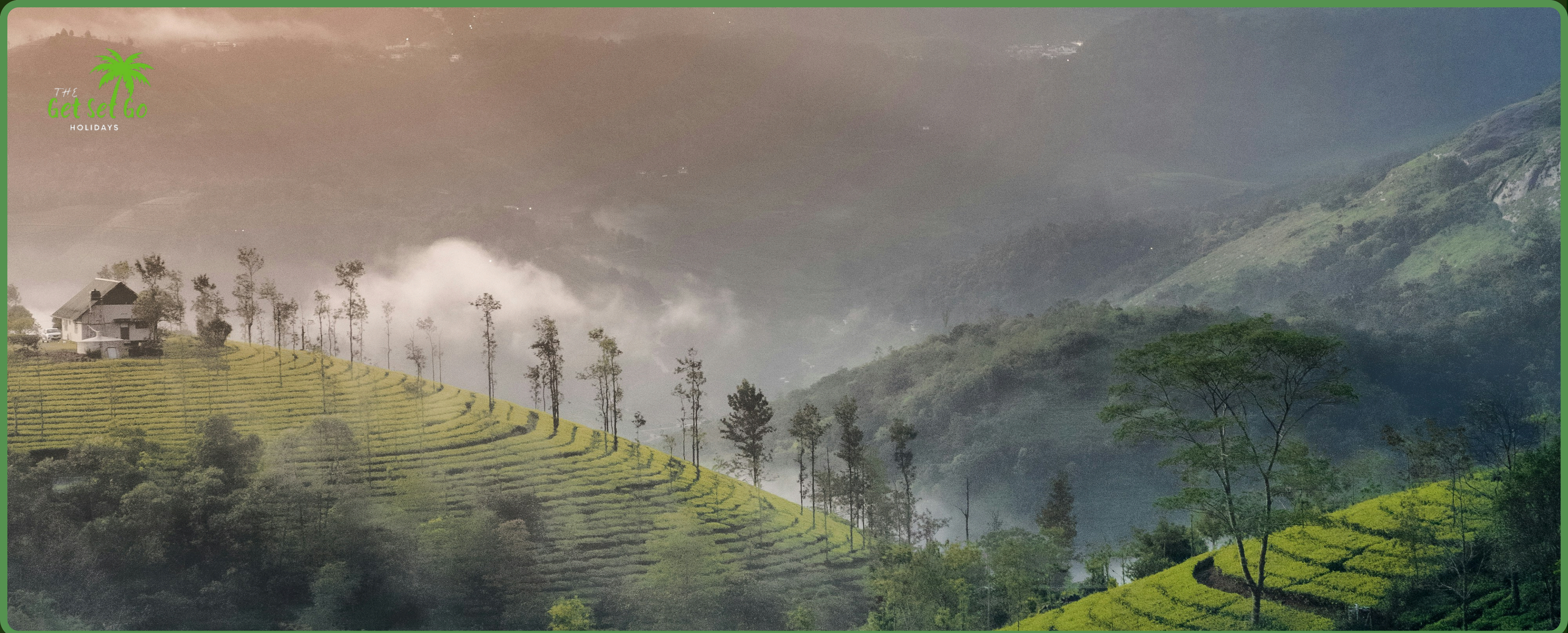
