

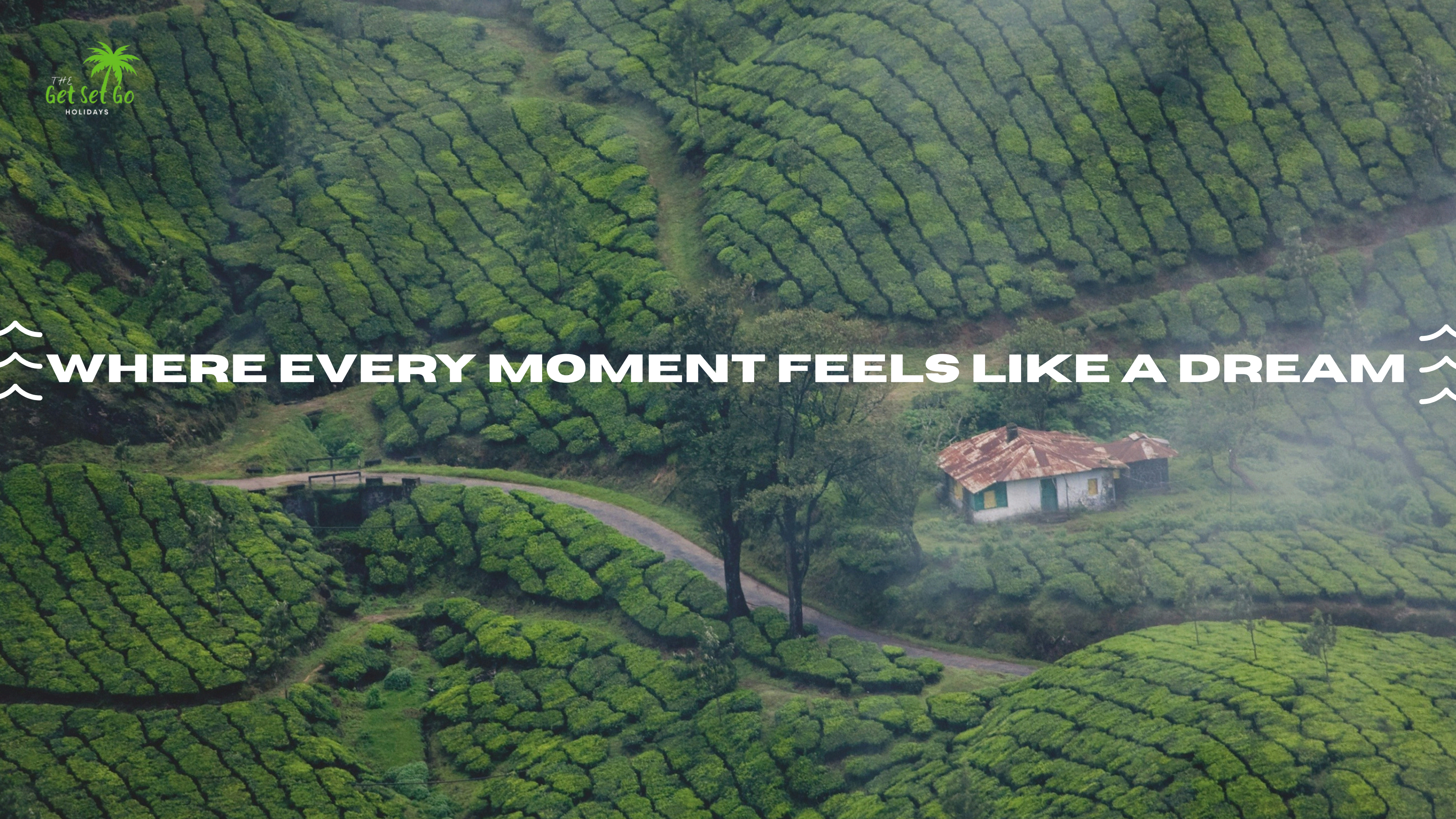

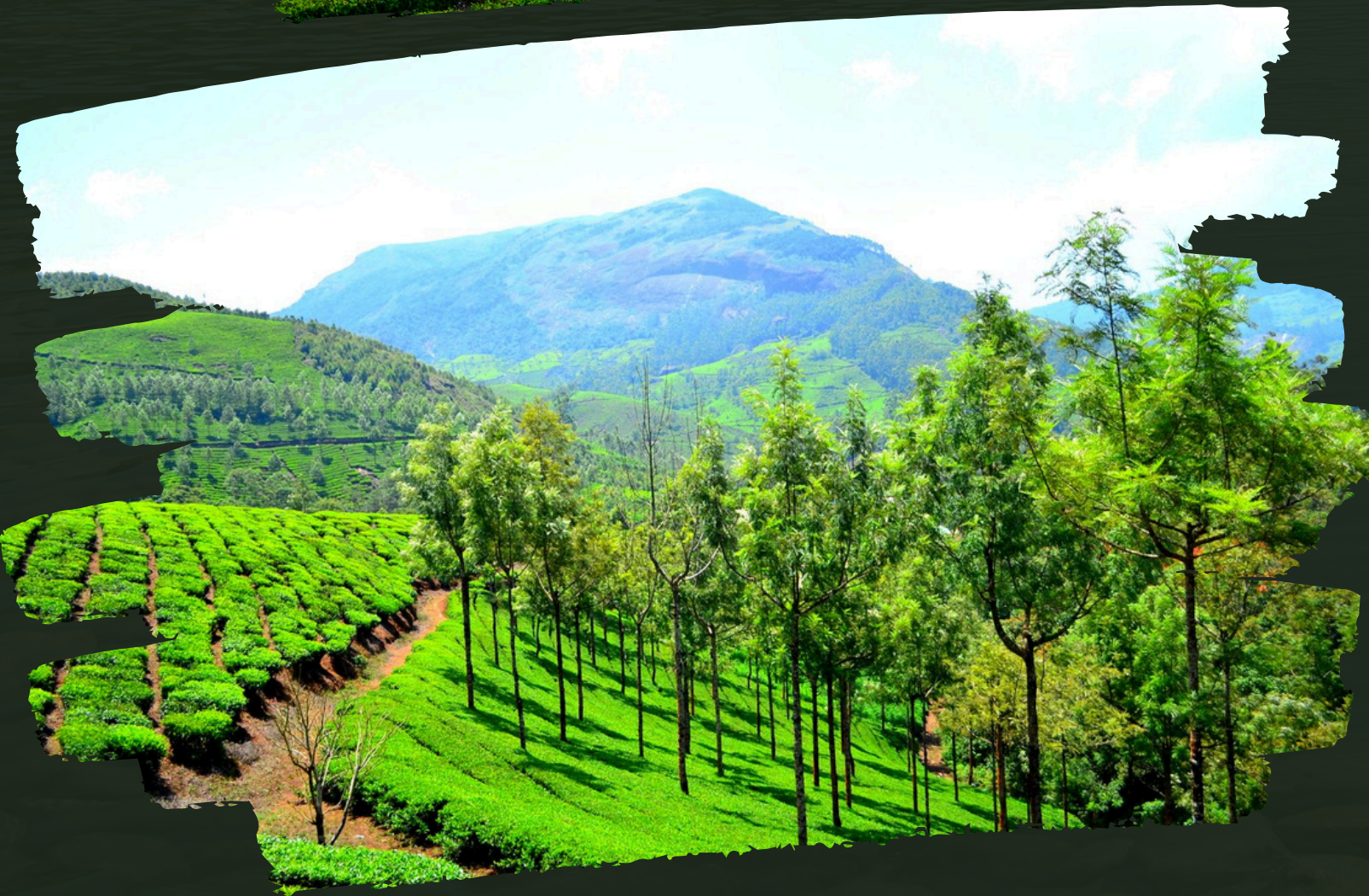

# MUNNAR

Munnar is a renowned hill station in Kerala's Idukki district, situated 1,600 meters above sea level in the Western Ghats. Famous for its vast tea plantations, misty valleys, and cool climate, it is a top South Indian tourist destination, formerly a British summer resort. Highlights include Eravikulam National Park and Anamudi peak.

## MATTUPETTY DAM

Mattupetty Dam is a popular tourist destination and vital infrastructure project located near Munnar in the Idukki district of Kerala, India. Situated at an altitude of 1,700 meters above sea level, it is known for its scenic beauty, perennial lake and role in hydroelectric power generation.



## TOP STATION

Top Station is one of the highest and most scenic viewpoints in Munnar, located approximately 1,700 meters (about 5,577 feet) above sea level in the Western Ghats. Situated on the border of Kerala and Tamil Nadu (about 32 km from Munnar town), it offers panoramic views of the surrounding valleys, tea plantations and the plains of Tamil Nadu's Theni district.



## ERAVIKULAM NATIONAL PARK

Eravikulam National Park, located near Munnar in Kerala's Western Ghats is a 97 km<sup>2</sup> protected area famous for conserving the endangered Nilgiri Tahr. Established in 1978, it features high-altitude grasslands, the 2,695-meter Anamudi Peak and hosts the 12-yearly Neelakurinji bloom. Visitors can explore the Rajamalai region, which offers stunning mountain views.

## KUNDALA DAM & LAKE

Kundala Dam and Lake located approximately 20-26 km from Munnar on the way to Top Station is a picturesque tourist destination in Kerala, India, widely recognized for its scenic beauty, tea plantations and its distinction as the first arch dam in Asia. Situated at an altitude of 1,700 meters above sea level, it is a key stop for visitors exploring the high-altitude regions of Munnar.



## TEA MUSEUM

The Tea Museum also known as the KDHP Tea Museum or Tata Tea Museum, is located in the scenic hill station of Munnar in Kerala, India. Established in 2005, it is a significant attraction designed to showcase the history, evolution and processing of tea in the region.



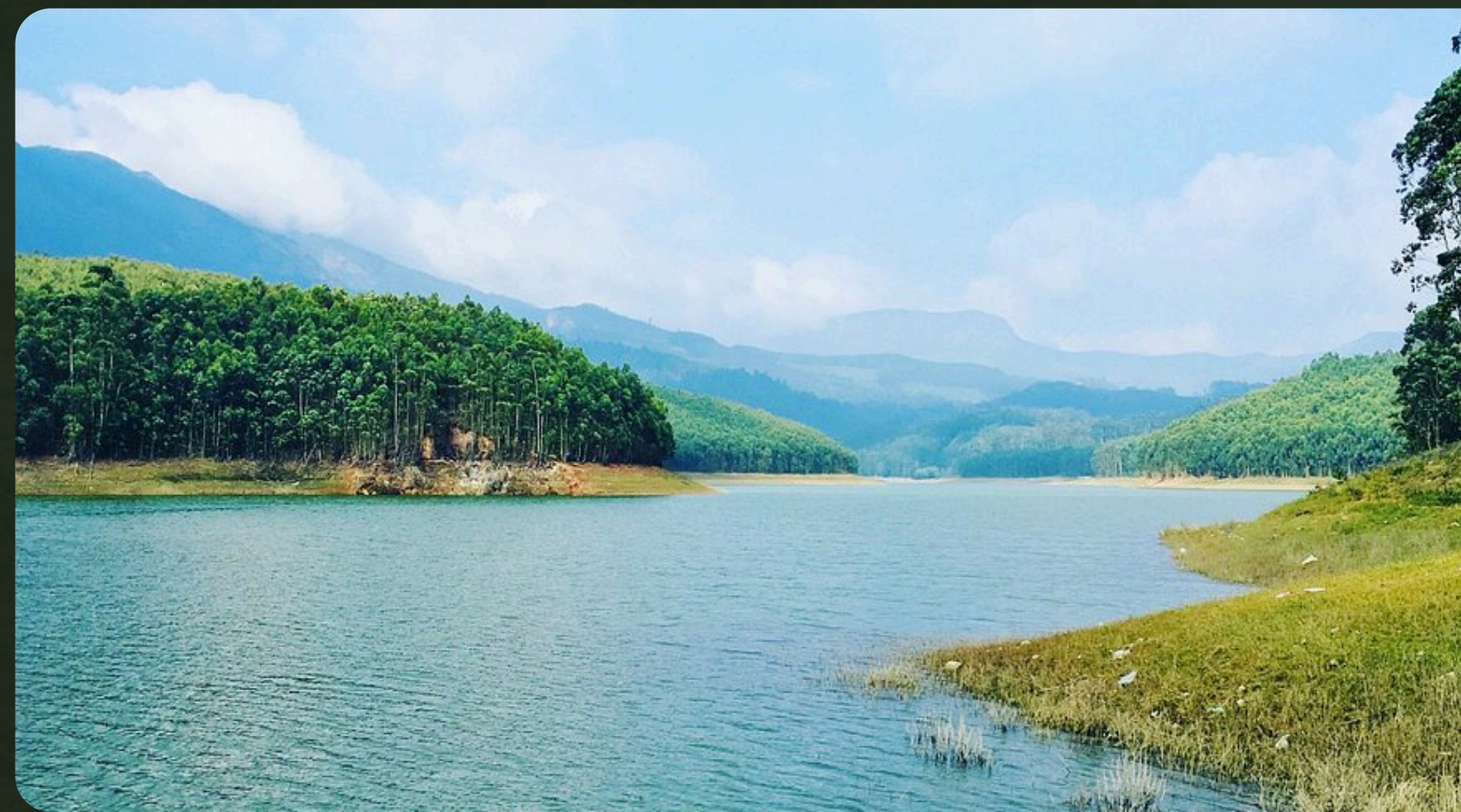


## POTHAMEDU VIEWPOINT

Pothamedu Viewpoint is a popular tourist attraction near Munnar in Kerala, India, renowned for its panoramic views of lush green tea, coffee, and cardamom plantations. Situated on a high hill, it offers visitors a bird's-eye view of the surrounding valleys, mist-clad hills, and the town of Munnar.

## ECHO POINT

Echo Point in Munnar is a popular scenic tourist spot in Kerala, India, renowned for its natural echo phenomenon and breathtaking surroundings. Situated at an altitude of about 600 feet, it is where the three mountain ranges (Mudrapuzha, Nallathanni, and Kundala) meet, offering a perfect blend of adventure and serene beauty.





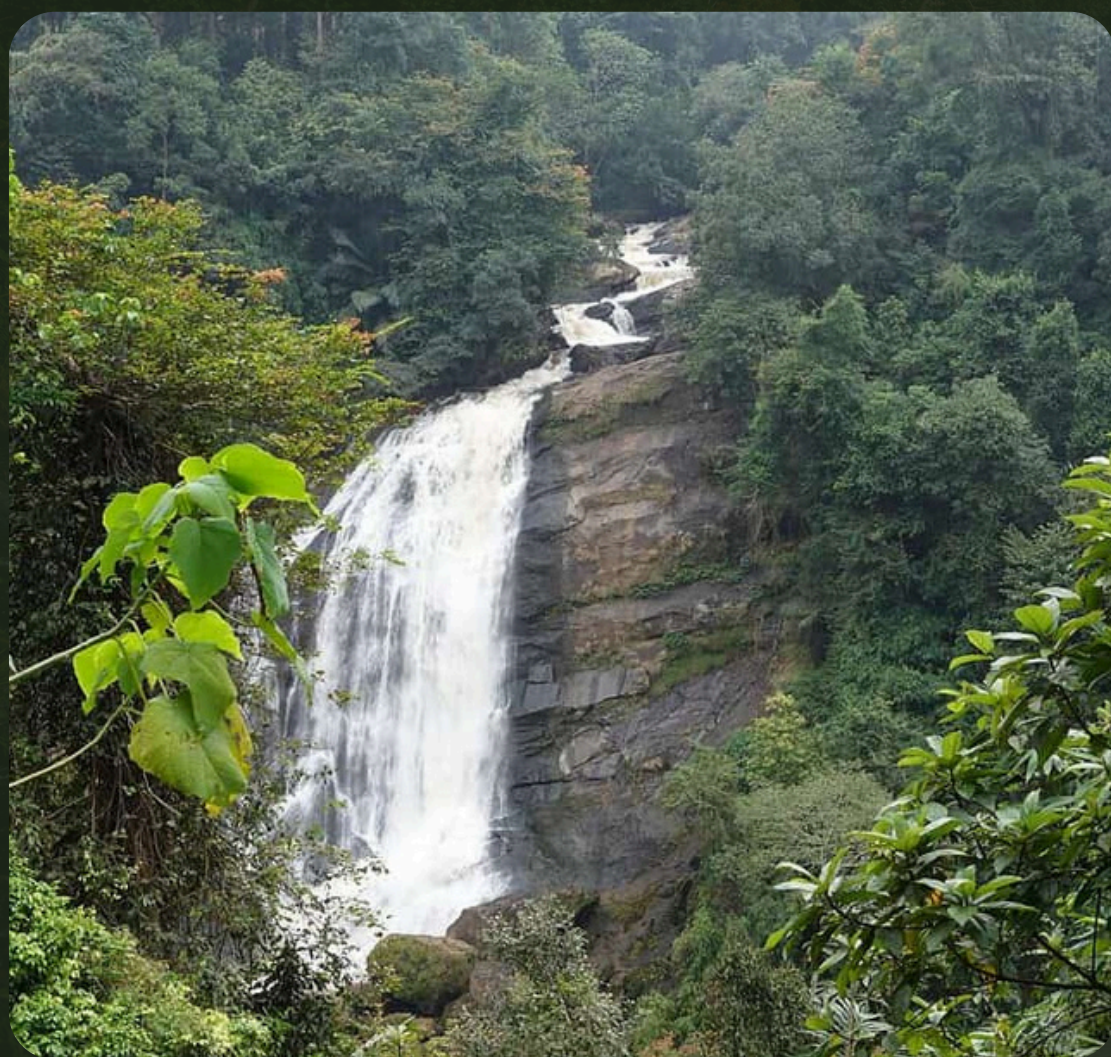
## KOLUKKUMALAI TEA ESTATE

Kolukkumalai Tea Estate located near Munnar in the Idukki district of Kerala, India, is widely recognized as the highest tea plantation in the world situated at an altitude of approximately 7,130 to 7,900 feet (about 2,170–2,400 meters) above sea level. Known for its breathtaking, rugged mountain views and exceptionally fresh, flavorful tea, it serves as a top destination for nature lovers and tea connoisseurs.



# WATERFALLS

Munnar a popular hill station in Kerala is renowned for its spectacular waterfalls, particularly vibrant during the monsoon and post-monsoon seasons (June to November). These falls surrounded by lush tea plantations, dense forests and steep rocky cliffs are major attractions for nature lovers and photographers.





# WONDER VALLEY ADVENTURE

Wonder Valley Adventure and Amusement Park is a nature-themed destination in Munnar that offers over 35 adventurous rides and activities for all ages. Located in Anachal, it is roughly 13 km from Munnar town and is designed to harmonize with the lush greenery of the Western Ghats.
