SISSU

Sissu, a scenic village in Himachal Pradesh's Lahaul Valley, is a rapidly growing tourist destination known for its stunning waterfall, tranquil lake, and year-round accessibility via the Atal Tunnel. Located along the Chandra River, it offers breathtaking views of snow-covered peaks, providing a blend of adventure and relaxation just 40 km from Manali. Best time to visit sissu from may to september.

SISSU WATERFALL (PALDEN LHAMO DHAR)

Sissu Waterfall, locally known as Palden Lhamo Dhar, is a majestic 50-meter glacial waterfall in Himachal Pradesh's Lahaul Valley, near Sissu village. Located ~40 km from Manali via the Atal Tunnel, this as mentioned in this scenic spot is a major tourist attraction offering breathtaking views of cascading water against lush green fields and rocky mountains, popular for short treks and viewing the falls from the nearby road.



SISSU LAKE/ BANK OF CHANDRA RIVER

Sissu (or Khagling), located in Himachal Pradesh's Lahaul Valley on the right bank of the Chandra River, is a scenic village famous for the Sissu Lake, spectacular Sissu Falls and snow-capped peaks. Situated ~40 km from Manali (via Atal Tunnel) at 3,120 meters, it offers year-round beauty, river rafting and camping.





GONDHLA FORT

Gondhla Fort is a historic 8-story tower located in Gondhla village, about 18 km from Sissu in Lahaul Valley. Built around 1700 AD, this timber bonded stone structure was the seat of the Thakurs of Gondhla. It offers a glimpse into traditional Himalayan architecture, though it is currently in a state of advanced deterioration due to neglect.





SISSU MONASTERY

Sissu Monastery (or Gompa) is a serene Buddhist temple located in Sissu village within the Lahaul Valley of Himachal Pradesh. Situated near the Manali-Leh Highway, it offers panoramic views of the Chandra River, Sissu waterfall and surrounding snow-capped mountains. The tranquil site provides a peaceful, authentic cultural experience for visitors.

SHITIDHAR GLACIER & GHEPAN LAKE

Ghepan Lake (or Ghepan Ghat) is a stunning, high-altitude turquoise lake located in the Lahaul Valley of Himachal Pradesh, accessible via a 28-34 km moderate trek from Sissu. Situated around 4,140-4,150 meters and named after local deity Raja Ghepan. This largely unexplored spot is characterized by floating icebergs surrounded by snow-capped peaks and vast meadows, offering a truly pristine Himalayan experience.



MIYAR VALLEY

The Miyar Valley, known as the "Valley of Flowers of Himachal" or "Yosemite of India" is a 75 km long, remote paradise located in the Lahaul region near Sissu and Udaipur. Renowned for its vast meadows, lush flowers and 36-km long glacier, it offers a serene trekking experience with panoramic views of peaks up to ~17,600 ft at Kang La Pass.
