SRIKALAHASTI

Srikalahasti, located in Andhra Pradesh's Tirupati district, is an ancient temple town renowned for the Srikalahasteeswara Temple. A key "Pancha Bhoota Sthalam" representing Vayu (air). The temple features a self manifested wind lingam, famous Rahu-Ketu Puja and is known as Dakshina Kailasam.

SRIKALAHASTEESWARA TEMPLE

The Srikalahasteeswara Temple, located in Srikalahasti, Andhra Pradesh, is a famous 5th-century Hindu temple dedicated to Lord Shiva as the Vayu Lingam (wind element). Known as a Pancha Bhoota Sthalam, it is famed for its Dravidian architecture and for performing specific Rahu-Ketu Pooja rituals to alleviate planetary doshas.



BHAKTA KANNAPPA TEMPLE

The Bhakta Kannappa Temple in Srikalahasti, Andhra Pradesh, is a small, sacred hilltop shrine dedicated to the legendary hunter devotee who sacrificed his eyes for Lord Shiva. Situated ~325 steps up next to the main Srikalahasti Temple, it offers panoramic town views and commemorates ultimate devotion.



PATHALA VINAYAKA TEMPLE

The Pathala Vinayaka Temple (or Pathala Ganapathi Temple) is a unique, ancient underground shrine located in the town of Srikalahasti, Andhra Pradesh, India. It is situated at the northern entrance (Gopuram) of the renowned Sri Kalahasteswara Temple, a major Shiva temple representing the Vayu Lingam (Wind Element).



DURGAMBIKA TEMPLE

The Kanaka Durga Temple (often referred to as Durgambika Temple) is one of the most prominent and historically significant Hindu temples in Andhra Pradesh, located in Vijayawada. It is situated on the Indrakeeladri hill overlooking the Krishna River.



SAHASRA LINGA TEMPLE

The Sahasra Linga Temple in Andhra Pradesh is a serene, ancient and often overlooked Shiva temple located near the famous temple town of Srikalahasti. It is known for its unique nature-integrated architecture where thousands of shivalingas are carved onto a single massive stone.



GUDIMALLAM TEMPLE

The Gudimallam Parasurameswara Swamy Temple in Andhra Pradesh is one of India's oldest Shiva shrines, famous for a 2,300 year old (circa 3rd century BCE) anthropomorphic Lingam. Located near Tirupati, it features a unique 5 foot tall seven sided Linga depicting Shiva as a hunter on a dwarf.

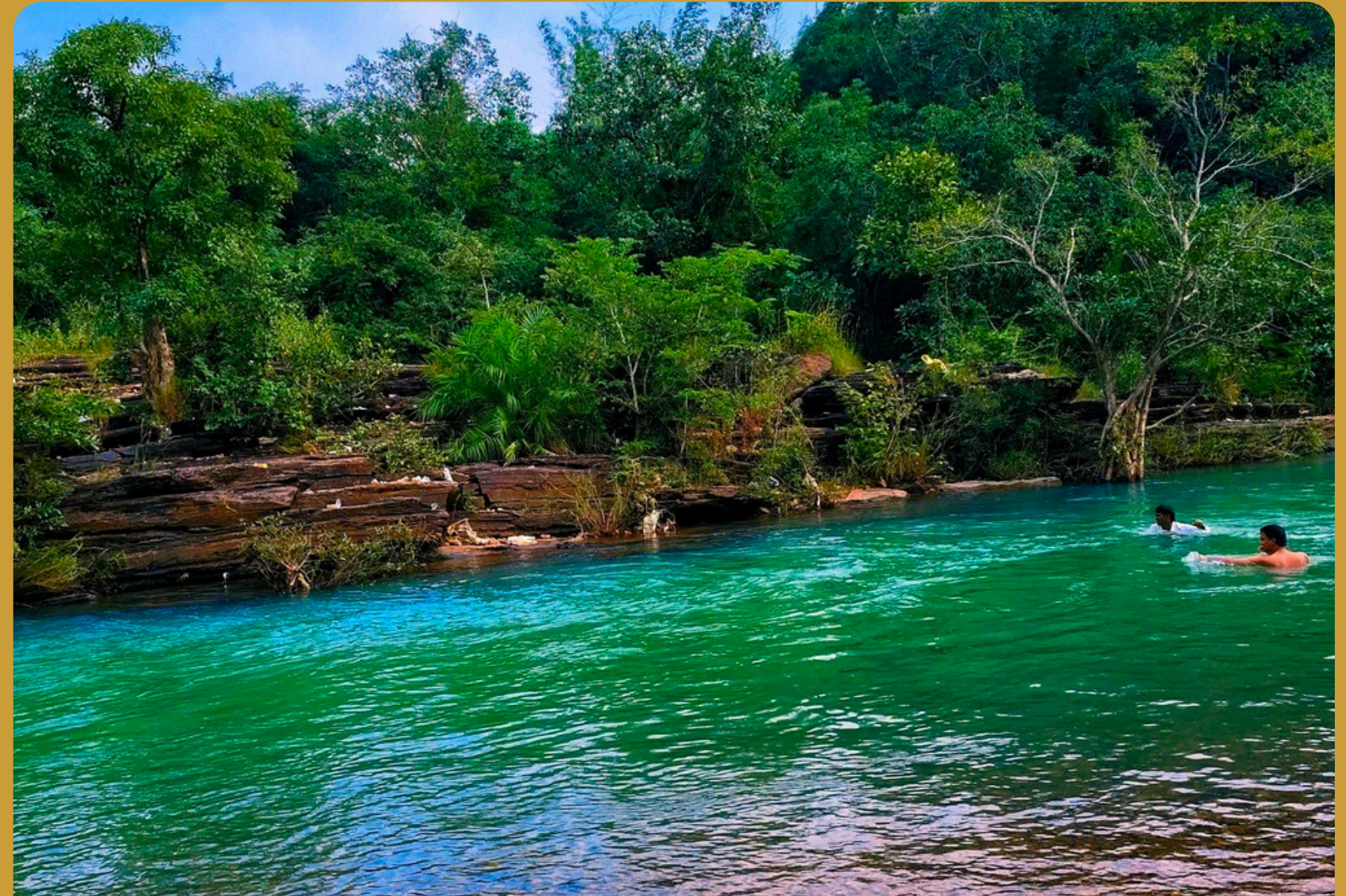


UBBALAMADUGU FALLS (TADA FALLS)

Ubbalamadugu Falls commonly known as Tada Falls is a popular natural waterfall and trekking destination in Chittoor district Andhra Pradesh, located about 95 km from Chennai. It offers a challenging 10 km round trip trek through rocky forested terrain to reach stunning cascading waterfalls ideal for nature lovers and adventurers

VEYILINGALA KONA WATERFALLS

Veyilingala Kona Waterfalls, known as the "Valley of the Thousand Lingas," is a scenic spiritual waterfall located about 7-10 km from Srikalahasti in Andhra Pradesh. It is famous for a small temple featuring a linga with 1,000 miniature lingas, featuring natural surroundings and a seasonal waterfall best visited during rainy seasons, ideal for quick nature trips.



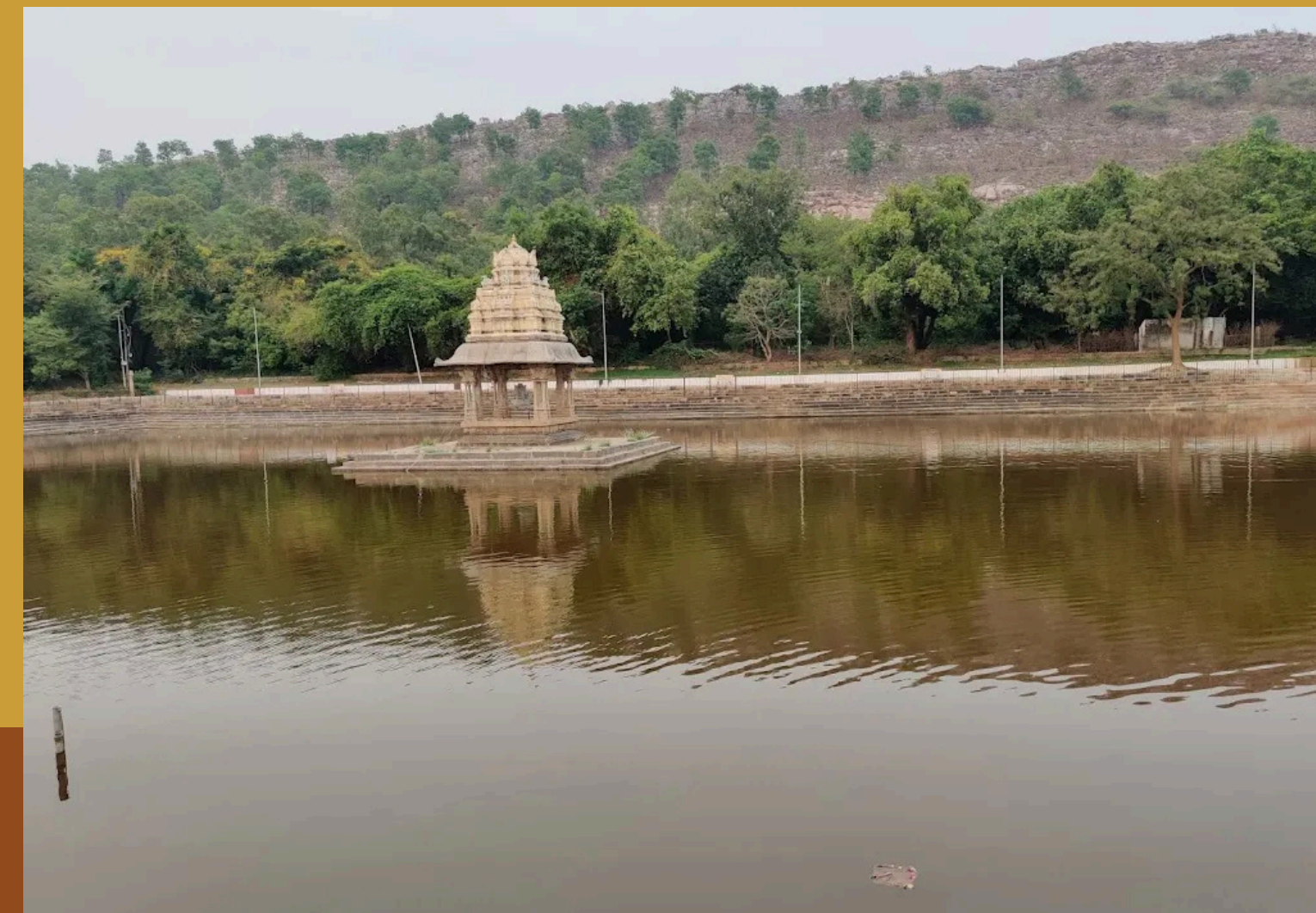
SWARNAMUKHI RIVER

The Swarnamukhi River is an independent, 130 km long east flowing river in Andhra Pradesh, originating in the Eastern Ghats near Pakala, Chittoor district and joining the Bay of Bengal. It holds immense spiritual significance, flowing through the sacred towns of Tirupati and Srikalahasti.



BHARADWAJA TIRTHAM

Bharadwaja Tirtham in Srikalahasti Andhra Pradesh, is a sacred serene water tank located about 6 km from the main Kalahastiswara temple. Named after Sage Bharadwaja who reportedly meditated here during Krutha Yuga. It is a serene scenic spot known for its rocky hills, a sacred pon, and a unique idol of Lord Vinayaka (Thapo Vinayaka) within the water.
