# SRINAGAR

Srinagar is the summer capital of Jammu & Kashmir, renowned for its stunning location on the Jhelum River, surrounded by the Himalayas. Situated at 1,585 meters, it is famous for Dal Lake houseboats, shikara rides, Mughal gardens (Shalimar, Nishat) and traditional Kashmiri handicrafts, often called the "Venice of the East".

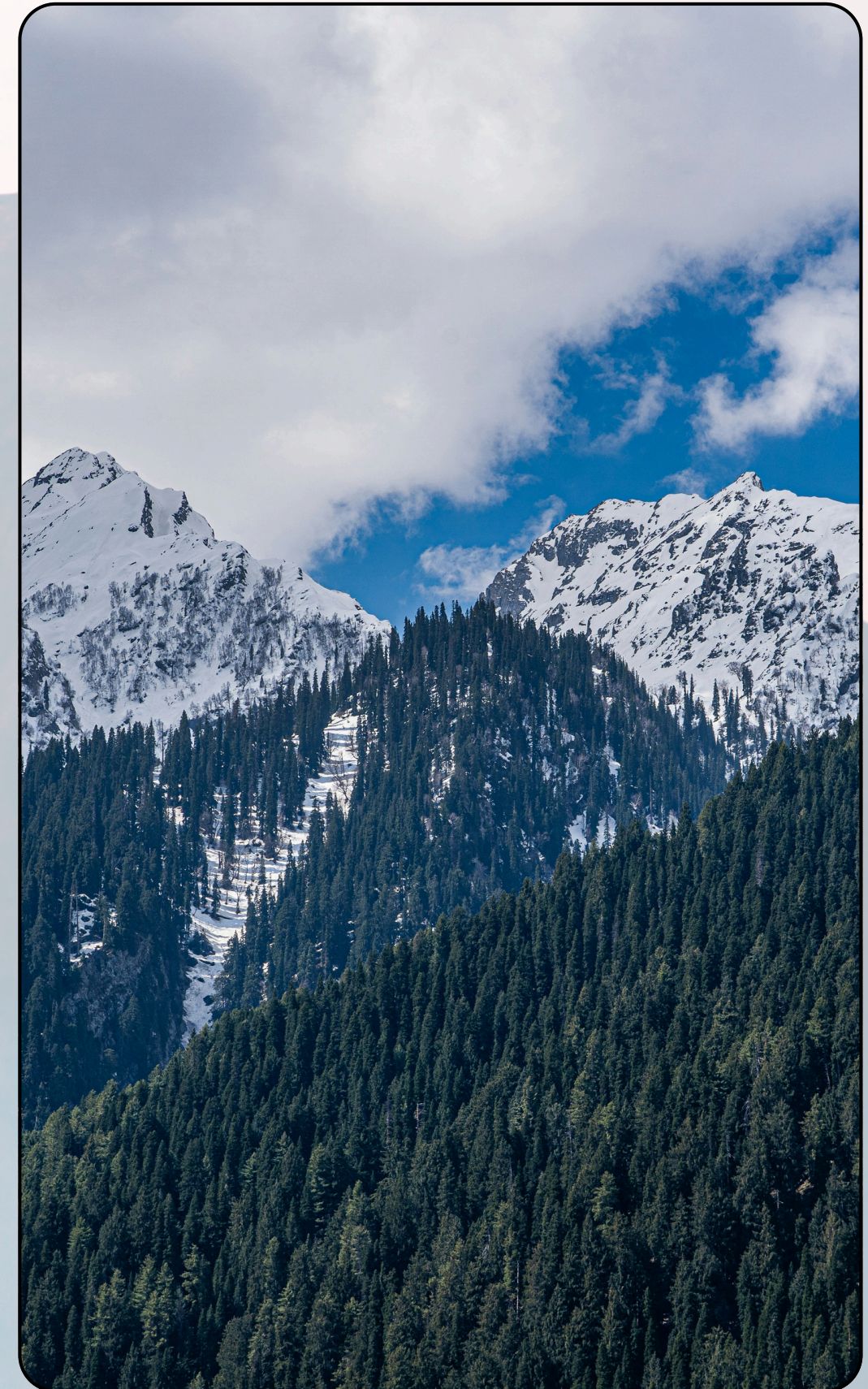

## DAL LAKE

Dal Lake, the "Jewel in the Crown of Kashmir," is a premier urban lake in Srinagar, Jammu & Kashmir, spanning roughly 7.44 km in length and 3.5 km in width. Located at an altitude of 1,583m, it offers iconic shikara rides, houseboat stays, and a floating market against the Pir Panjal mountains.



## MUGHAL GARDEN

The Mughal Gardens in Srinagar are a collection of stunning historically significant gardens built during the Mughal era (roughly 16th to 17th century) in the Persian style. Located on the banks of Dal Lake and at the foothills of the Zabarwan Mountains, they are renowned for their terraced design, water cascades, fountains and vibrant, fragrant flowers, serving as a peaceful escape.





## SHANKARACHARYA TEMPLE

Dal Lake, the "Jewel in the Crown of Kashmir," is a premier urban lake in Srinagar, Jammu & Kashmir, spanning roughly 7.44 km in length and 3.5 km in width. Located at an altitude of 1,583m, it offers iconic shikara rides, houseboat stays, and a floating market against the Pir Panjal mountains.

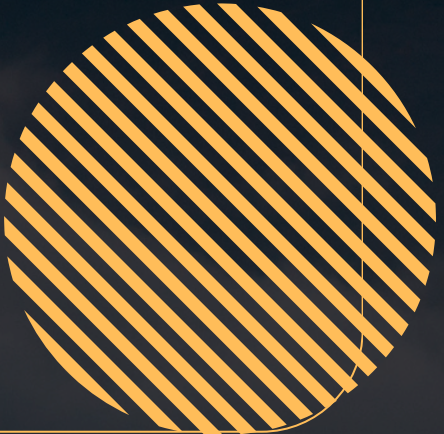


## INDIRA GANDHI MEMORIAL TULIP GARDEN

The Indira Gandhi Memorial Tulip Garden in Srinagar is recognized as the largest tulip garden in Asia. Located at the foothills of the Zabarwan Range and overlooking the iconic Dal Lake, it spans approximately 30 hectares (74 acres). For the 2026 season, the garden officially opened on March 16 and is expected to remain open until mid April.

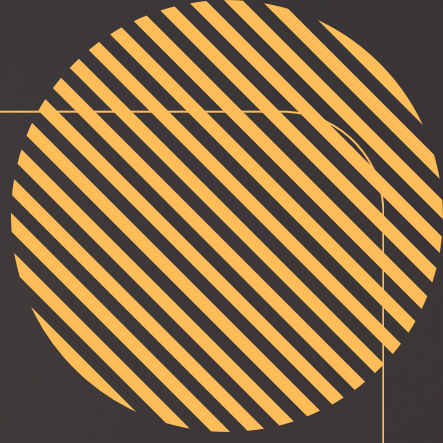
## PARI MAHAL

Pari Mahal, often called the "Palace of Fairies" or "Abode of Fairies", is a stunning seven-terraced Mughal garden and historical monument located on the top of the Zabarwan Mountain range in Srinagar, Jammu and Kashmir. It overlooks the picturesque Dal Lake and the city of Srinagar, making it one of the most popular tourist attractions in the region.



## NIGEEN LAKE

Nigeen Lake (or Nagin Lake), located in Srinagar, Jammu and Kashmir, is a beautiful and serene water body frequently described as an offshoot of the famous Dal Lake. It is renowned for being quieter, cleaner, and deeper than its more popular neighbor, providing a peaceful retreat for tourists.



## HAZRATBAL SHRINE

The Hazratbal Shrine, also known as Dargah Sharif, Assar e Sharief or Madinat us Sani, is a revered Sufi shrine and mosque located on the left bank of the Dal Lake in Srinagar, Jammu and Kashmir. It is widely considered to be the holiest Muslim religious site in Kashmir.



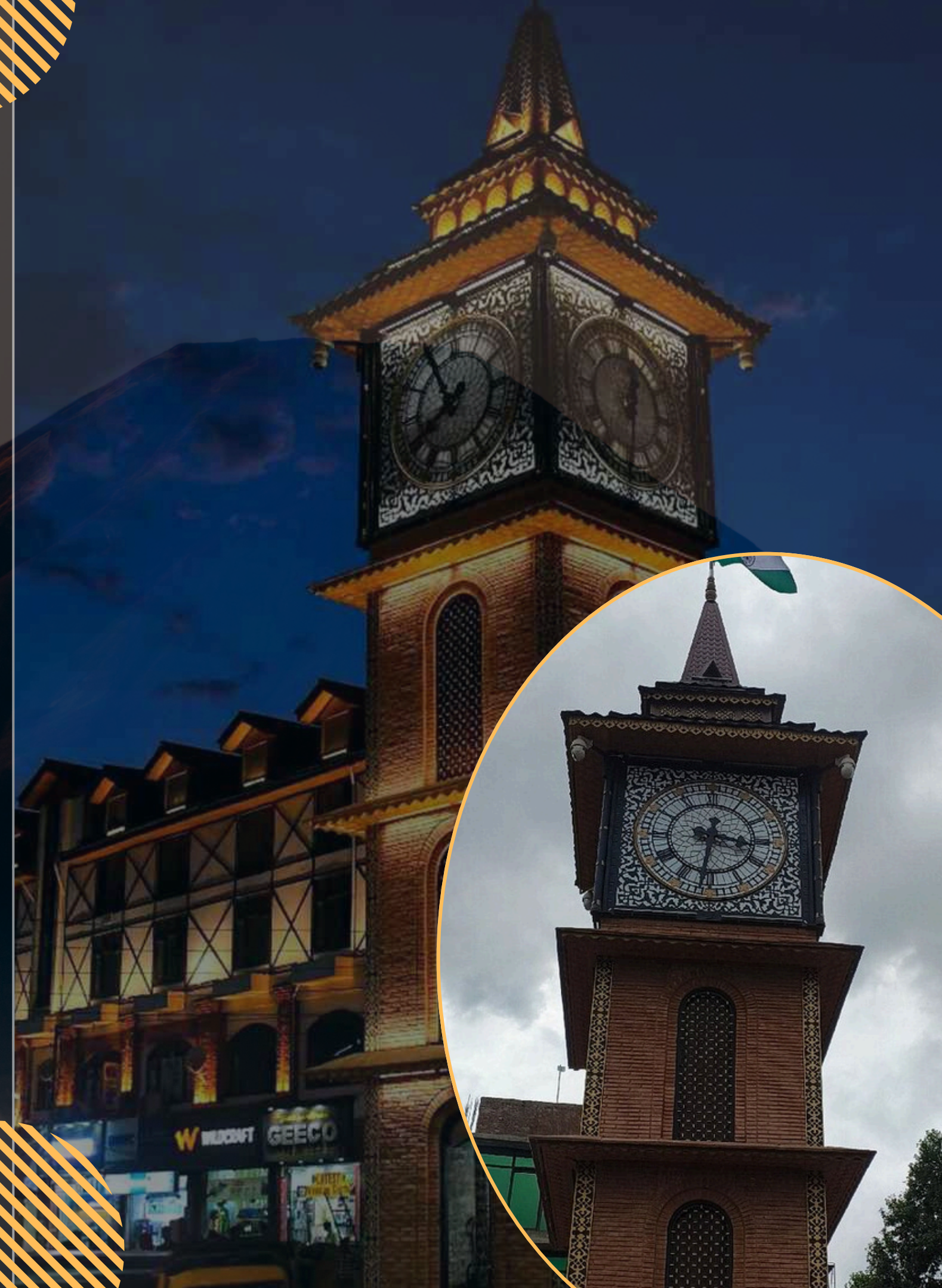
## OLD CITY & JAMIA MASJID

The Jamia Masjid in Srinagar is one of the most historically and religiously significant mosques in the Kashmir Valley, located in the heart of the "Old City" (Downtown area) at Nowhatta. It is the largest mosque in Kashmir and a premier example of traditional Indo Saracenic architecture, serving as a center for both worship and political life in the region.



# LAL CHOWK

Lal Chowk, located in the heart of Srinagar, Jammu and Kashmir is a historic city square, major commercial hub and a significant landmark that has transitioned from a center of political unrest to a vibrant, renovated tourist spot. Known as "Red Square" (due to its association with socialist ideology in local politics, similar to Moscow's Red Square). It is most famous for its iconic clock tower, the Ghanta Ghar.





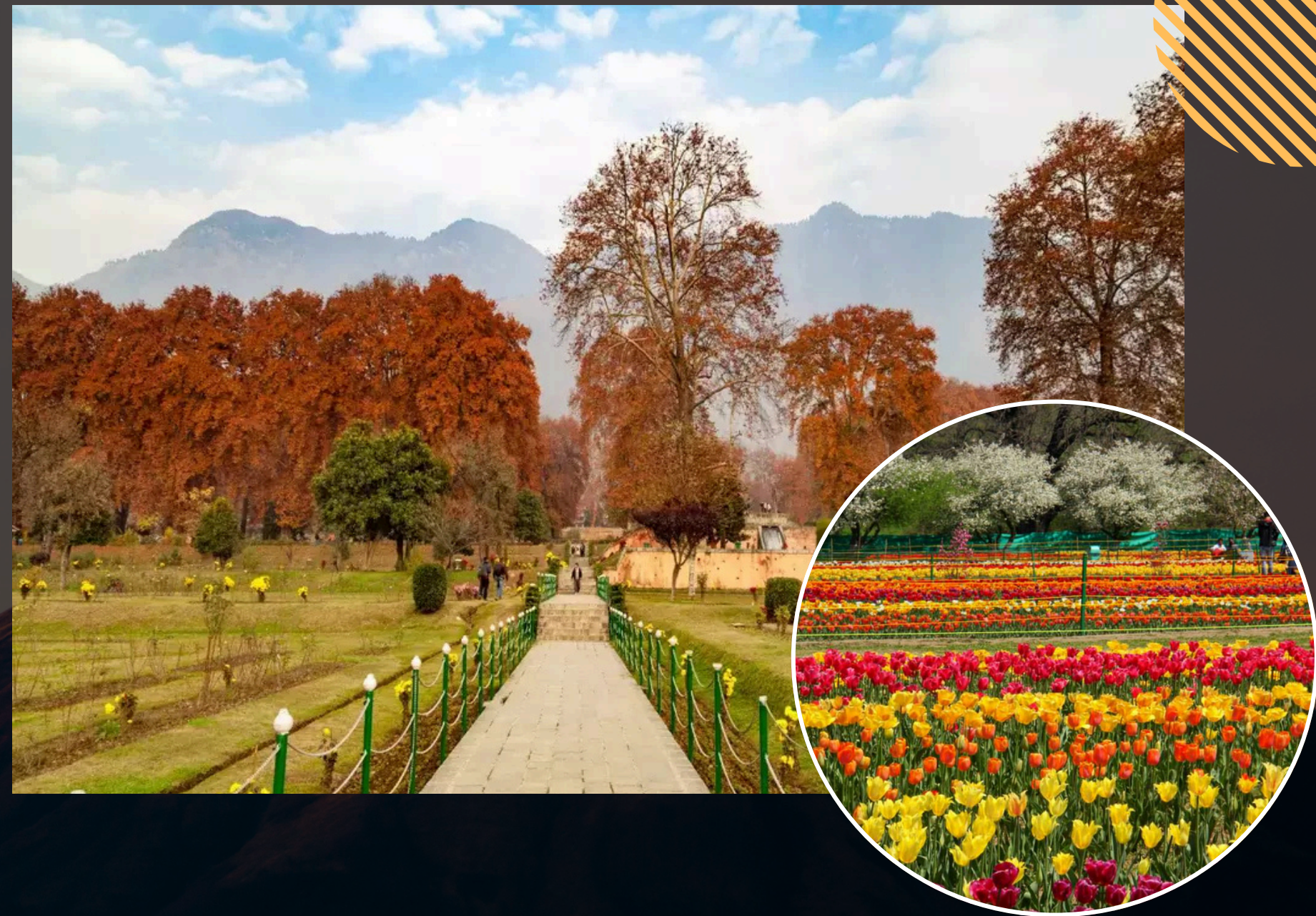
## SHIKARA RIDE
